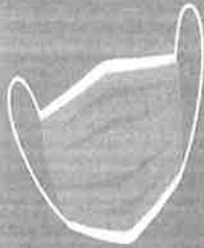

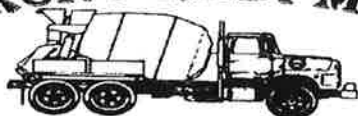
## Peace Poles/Garden Poles Collective Collaboration Project

Accounts in arrears by more than 45 days may be subject to disconnection without further notice.

Now that the snow has arrived, please remember the Town of Bruno's Snow Removal Bylaw. When shoveling snow remember to pile it on your own property, please **do not** pile it in the street or on the sidewalk, that can make walking and driving very difficult and potentially dangerous. This holiday season affects two Bruno Transfer Station dates. The transfer station will be **closed on December 25th, 2021 and January 1st, 2022.**



After a significant snow fall, if you are able to, please remove your vehicles from the roadway so Public Works can get the roads clear of snow and safe for driving. All roadways must be cleared before any sand or salt is able to be spread. Having as many vehicles removed from the roadway as possible allows them to remove as much snow as possible from the road as well as allows them to get it done faster.
