ST. THERESE NEWS

Hello Everyone,

I thought I would take this opportunity to let the community of Bruno know that St. Therese will be moving forward with our young adult formation program this fall. At the end of March all programs were suspended at St. Therese due to the COVID-19 Corona Virus and at that time we were not sure what would be happening this fall. Since then, the staff have been working on developing COVID-19 protocols and guidelines with the information available from SaskHealth to try and ensure a safe environment for the students and staff, as well as the broader community. To date we have processed a similar number of applications as in previous years and will be expecting the last of our staggered student arrivals by August 31. For both your and our students' safety, students will be remaining primarily on St. Therese grounds throughout the year. Also, due to provincial "public gathering" restrictions, we anticipate that there will be no public events on-site at St. Therese during the 2020-2021 school year.

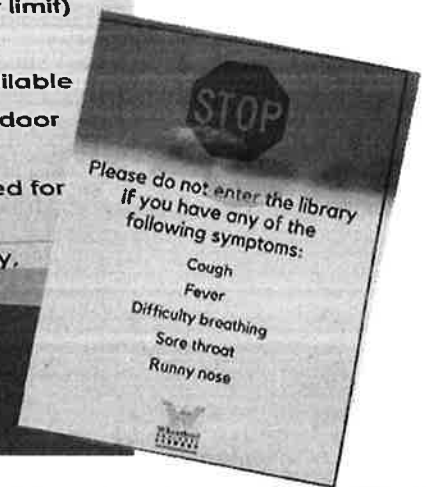
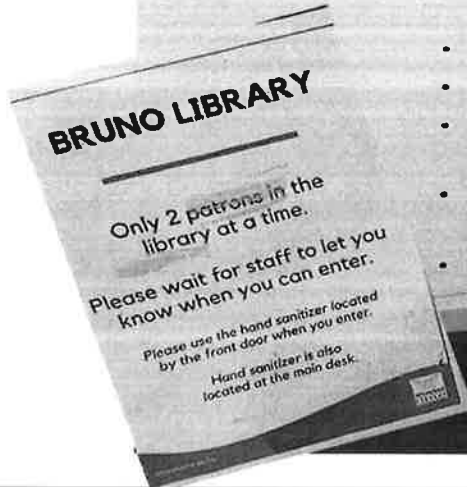

2020 ELECTION

What are the responsibilities of council?

Council has the power to make decisions about municipal services, establish policies and provide direction for the operation of the municipality. Council makes decisions about what services to provide, how those services will be delivered and at what levels. Members of council are accountable to the people who elect them.

I'm not trained & haven't had any experience...

It is not crucial to have education or experience in a government setting to run for council. You likely have skills, knowledge and abilities that are transferable to the council member's role.

Do I qualify to be a candidate?

- You must be 18 years of age on election day
- Be a Canadian citizen
- Have resided in the municipality for at least 3 consecutive months preceding the date you hand in your nomination
- Are eligible to be nominated as provided for in The Local Government Election



How much time will it require?

If elected, you will serve a four-year term. During that time, you should plan to attend the following:

- Regular & special council meetings
- Meetings of Council committees
- Meetings of other boards and agencies as a representative of council
- Conferences, seminars, workshops and conventions for training and discussion
- Events that promote or represent your municipality.

What is the purpose and role of council?

It is council's role to not only provide good government but to also provide the services and facilities that council feels necessary and desirable for all or part of the municipality. Council also fosters economic, social and environmental well being while providing wise stewardship of public assets. You could help to develop and maintain a safe and viable community.

How do I file my nomination?

Once the Town of Bruno publishes a *Notice of Call for Nominations*, you can file your completed nomination paper and all required attachments with Colette at the Town Office during regular office hours. If you need assistance with your form or have questions please contact the Town Office.

Volunteer Recognition Award

The volunteer recognition program is organized by
The Town of Bruno in conjunction with The RM of Bayne

to recognize the contributions that volunteers provide to sport, culture, recreation and overall community involvement. Its purpose is to recognize the volunteer contributions of people active in developing, administering or providing programs and activities.

Nominations must fall under one or more of the following categories:

- **SPORT** – An individual whose leadership qualities contribute to the development of sport. This can include leadership, coaching, administration or participation in physical activities for enjoyment, fitness or excellence at all skill levels.

- **CULTURE** – An individual whose volunteer efforts have contributed to the overall cultural identity of their community. This may encompass the area of heritage conservation, arts, or multiculturalism.
- **COMMUNITY INVOLVEMENT** - An individual who has shown exemplary community involvement and development. The individual has exhibited strong community spirit and pride and has enhanced the community through their actions.
