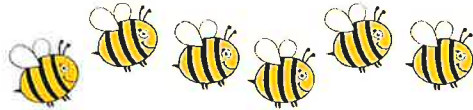

BORROW A REGIONAL PARK PASS FROM YOUR LIBRARY

We are partnering again with the Regional Parks to have park passes available for loan at our branch.

They are good at any regional park in Saskatchewan. The passes are good for park access for one vehicle and its occupants. Camping fees, firewood fees etc are NOT included with this pass. The pass will only get you into the regional park.

The passes:

- Are first come first serve - they cannot be set aside for people
- Non-holdable/non-requestable
- Loan period is 7 days, this cannot be extended
- Passes must be returned to the library they were borrowed from
- Patrons must have a valid library card to check out

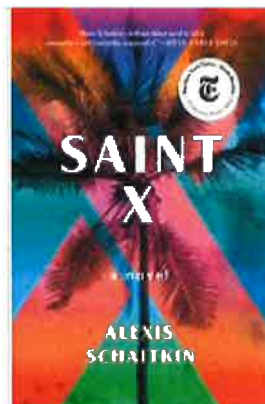
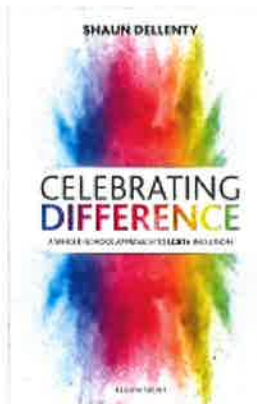
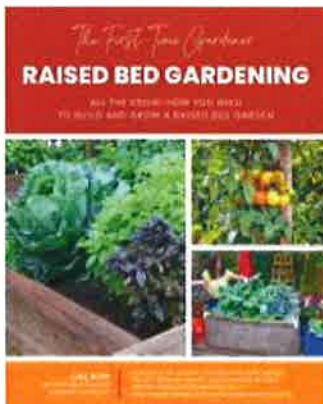

 - Food Vendors supply their own materials, do their own set up and retain their own profits. The Old Fire Hall Committee profits went toward the repair of the back wall of the old Fire Hall. The Lions used their profits to support community projects. The Golf Club used their

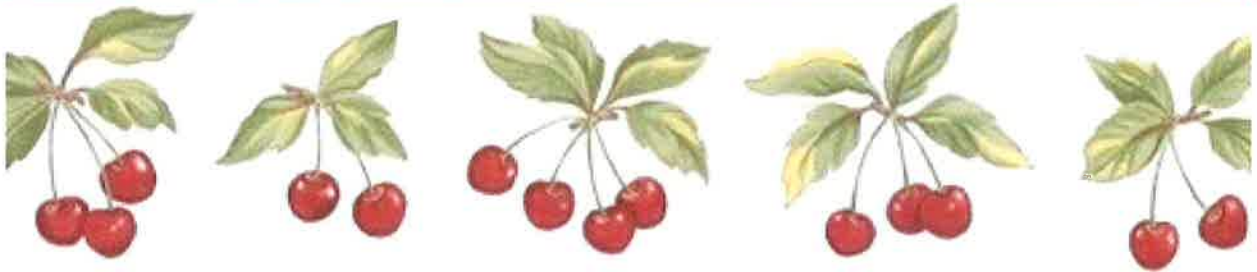

- Gasoline must be in a ULC-approved gas can or jerry can.

Examples: acetone, BBQ lighter fluid, camping fuel, flammable degreaser, flammable fuel additives, flammable liquid additives, flammable lubricants, fondue fuel, gasoline, gasoline contaminated w/ oil or water (must be in a ULC jerry can), methanol, mineral spirits, paint stripper/ remover, paint thinner, turpentine, Varsol, windshield washer fluid.



Explosive Symbol

PHYSICALLY HAZARDOUS (fuel cylinders, non-refillable - under 5kg)

- The product label **must display** the flammable symbol in an octagon and the explosive symbol.

Examples 1 lb propane cylinders, camp fuel cylinders, butane, MAPP gas torch fuel cylinders.

AEROSOLS (flammable, toxic, pesticides and/or corrosive)

- The product label **must display** the explosive **AND** flammable, toxic, poison or corrosive symbols in an octagon.

Examples: lubricant, spray glue, insect repellent, brake cleaner, butane refills. Cosmetic or beauty products are **NOT** accepted.



Poison Symbol in Octagon

TOXIC (liquids) - Under 10L

- The product label **must display** the poison symbol in an Octagon.

Examples furniture stripper automotive additives, lubricants, tar & bug remover.



Poison Symbol

PESTICIDES (liquids and solids) - Under 10L/10Kg

- The product label **must display** the poison symbol **AND** a Pest Control Products number **AND** the word "Domestic."

Examples: yard & garden chemicals, anti-fouling paint, sanitizer, and disinfectants.



Corrosive Symbol in Octagon

CORROSIVE (liquids and solids) - Under 10L/10Kg

- The product label **must display** the corrosive symbol in an octagon.

Examples: rust remover, pool & hot tub chemicals, grout cleaner, ammonia bleach

Examples of Not-Accepted Products

Ammunition, Batteries, Caulking compound, Cosmetics and beauty products, Diesel, Medical sharps, Fertilizer, and Mercury Switches.

- Household waste only - No waste marked or sold as industrial or agricultural.
- Original containers only - No repackaged waste.
- Original labels only - Original container **must have** the original label.
- Sealed containers only - Must be leak-proof, generally the original cap must be attached.
- Pesticide container must show the Pest Control Product number, the word "Domestic," and a toxic symbol. **Note that many typical household "pesticides" such as Roundup, Killox, and others DO NOT have a poisonous symbol and are NOT accepted.**
- Motor Oil and Antifreeze are not accepted.
- Batteries over 5 kg, car batteries, and light bulbs are not accepted.

Other Recycling Opportunities: Not accepted at this event, but available to residents
