2021 Annual Notice to Consumers**

### Introduction

The Water Security Agency (WSA) requires that at least once each year waterworks owners provide notification to consumers of the quality of water produced and supplied as well as information on the performance of the waterworks in submitting samples as required by a Permit to Operate a Waterworks. The following is a summary of the Town of Bruno's water quality and sample submission compliance record for the January 1, 2021 to December 31, 2021 time period. This report was completed on March 28<sup>th</sup>, 2022. Readers should refer to the Agency's Municipal Drinking Water Quality Monitoring Guidelines, November 2015, EPB 202 for more information on minimum sample submission requirements and the meaning of type of sample. Permit requirements for a specific waterworks may require more sampling than outlined in the Agency's monitoring guidelines. 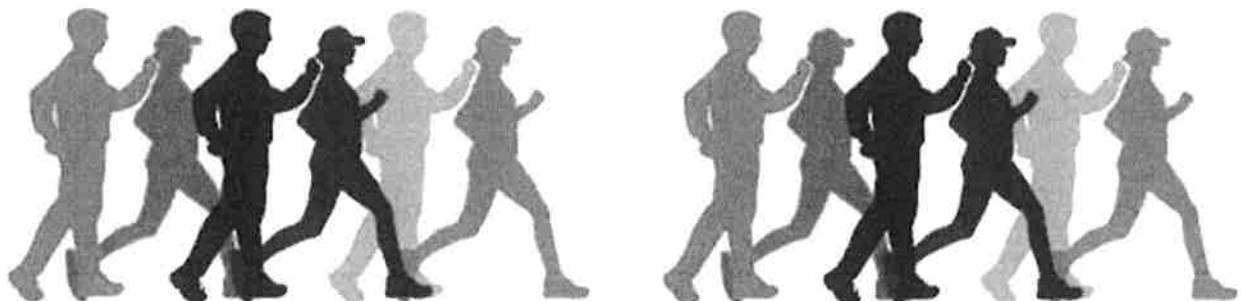

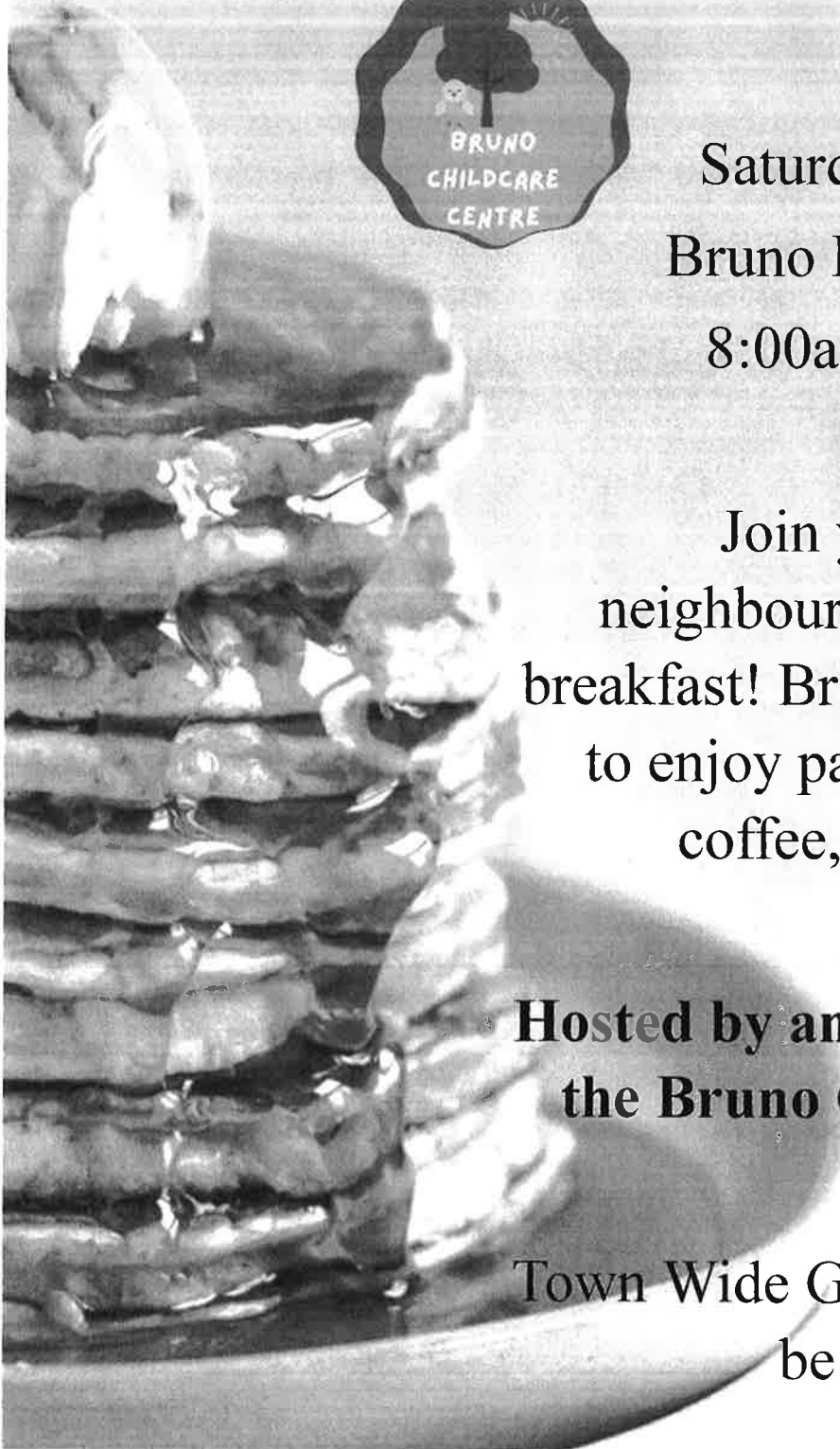

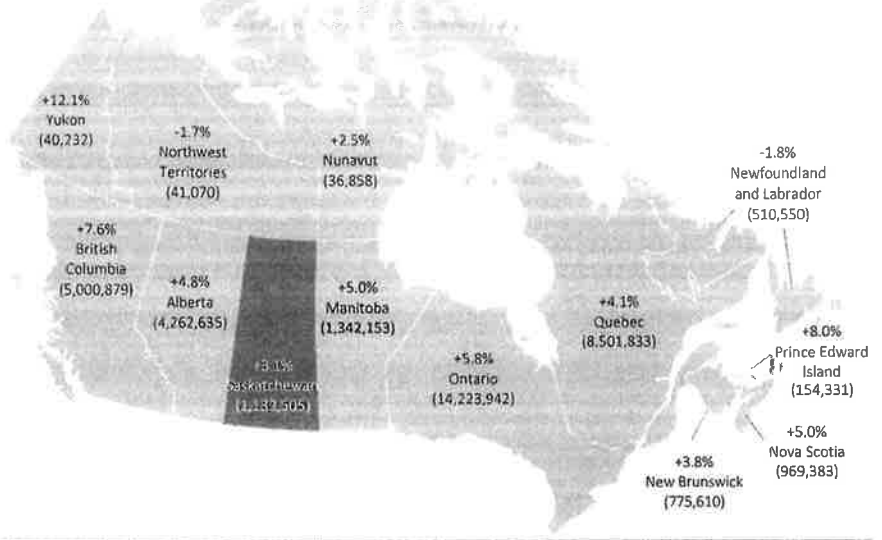

### **Who We Are**

The Bruno Childcare Centre Committee has been formed to provide an important service to the community of Bruno and surrounding area. We are a volunteer, non-profit group looking to meet the growing childcare demands with a Childcare Centre within the immediate Bruno area.

### **Our Community**

Bruno is a vibrant rural community that more than 600 people call home and has continued to grow over recent years. Many have returned to the community to raise their young families and others to experience the relaxed pace of rural Saskatchewan living. Results from a survey conducted within the community showed that there are currently 25 families requiring daycare services and an additional 10 families requiring before and after school care.

### **Our Goal**

Our goal is to provide a licensed full-time childcare centre for children 12 months and older along with a before and after school program with close access to Bruno Central School, right in the town of Bruno. Our vision is to create a safe, positive and fun space for the children of our community to attend!

### **Project**

We have secured a purchase of the former hatchery building (642 Ursuline Ave. Bruno, SK.) for our daycare centre, with support from Proveta Nutrition. Extensive interior renovations are required, including but not limited to framing and completing the interior, upgrades to electrical and plumbing, as well as window installations. Renovations are scheduled to begin June 1, 2022. Below is an overview of our expected costs of renovation and start up purchases.

We also as a group would like to keep our childcare costs as low as possible for our families and would like to raise funds to offset operational costs as well.

### **Community Benefits**

Accessible and quality childcare will benefit the healthy development of our children and improve the economic health of families and our economy. Access to childcare is a major factor in parents being able to go back to work. Access to childcare for families would increase workplace retention rates and especially support the retention and advancement of women in the workplace. Many families within our community struggle to balance family and work while providing their children with quality care, if any at all. With access to a necessary service such as childcare our community will more likely be better able to attract and retain residents and employees within the community. The Bruno Childcare Centre project will create job opportunities in Early Childhood Education for Bruno and be an investment for the future of education for our children.

### **Our Efforts**

We have already begun fundraising efforts by planning to host the town wide pancake breakfast, a golf tournament and steak supper with the help of the Bruno Lions Club, a Canada Day celebration and a Ladies Night out Event. Our fundraising efforts will be ongoing with a goal of being able to open our doors by Winter 2023.
