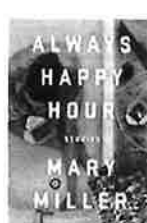

Cinnamon


In Saskatchewan, a tipi is a symbol of Indigenous identity. In the past, many First Nations Peoples on the prairies lived in a tipi, but a tipi is much more than a house. Every piece of the tipi has a different meaning and teaching, and setting the tipi up is a sacred ceremony that has been passed from generation to generation.

The Cree people use 15 poles to create the structure of a tipi. Each pole has a very special meaning that represents a guiding principle for Indigenous peoples, families and communities. The poles are tied together at the top with a rope. The rope ties the poles and the teachings together. The tipi is strong, and the teachings help to keep a family inside strong.

The kit you have received includes three of the tipi teachings:

- Pole 5- Love
- Pole 9- Strength
- Pole 14- Children to Grow up

Enjoy learning and teaching together!

Attention Utility Customers
Please be aware that as of January 1st, 2022, the Town of Bruno will discontinue using individual residential door notices for final warning on overdue utility accounts.
All accounts are due within 30 days of the meter being read.
Overdue notices will be mailed or emailed on accounts overdue by more than 45 days. Accounts in arrears by more than 45 days may be subject to disconnection without further notice

Please remember to pay your tax accounts! All accounts in arrears will be sent to a tax enforcement company, TaXervice. If your account is in arrears that means you will be contacted by them directly during all stages of tax enforcement. If your account is sent to TaXervice, there will be a registration fee as well as a title search fee that will be added to your account.

Notice to Businesses: All business licenses expire January 1st of each year. Please be sure to renew your business license by coming into the Town Office, or call us for contactless payment options 306-369-2514. Business Licenses are required in order to operate a business within the Town of Bruno. Licenses are required by:

- ⇒ All persons carrying out business within the Municipality
- ⇒ Direct sales and transient traders
- ⇒ Contractors
- ⇒ Home based businesses
- ⇒ Tradeshow organizers

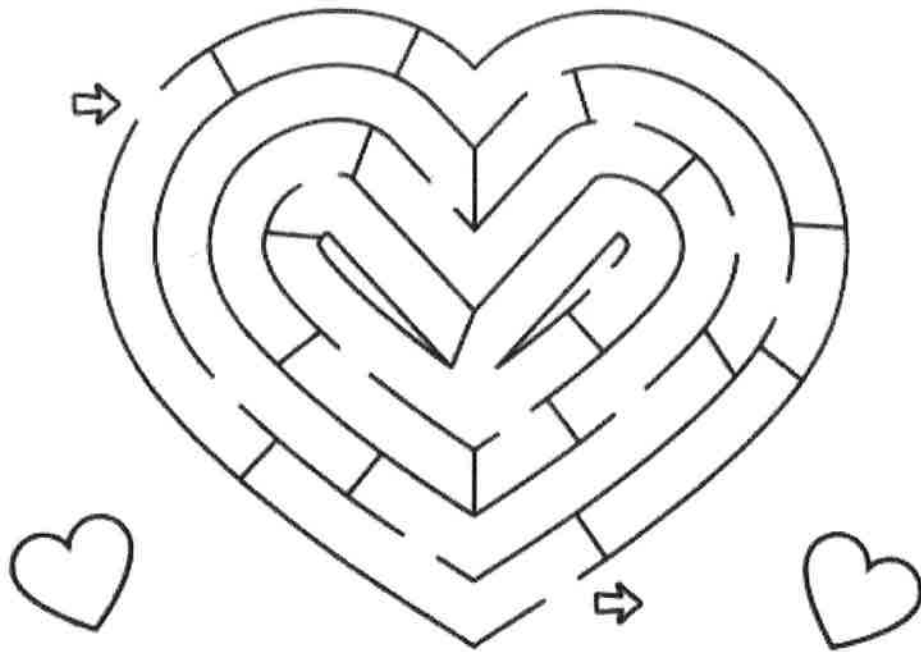

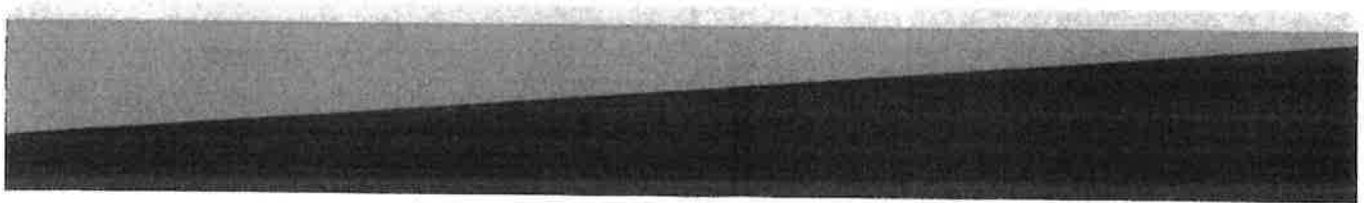
