**\*\* Correction to the January 2020 Bruno Bits\*\***

All pet licenses expired on **January 1<sup>st</sup>, 2020**. If you have a dog(s) or cat(s), please stop in at the Town Office to register or renew your pets license. Registering your pet and having the Town of Bruno tag can help identify a lost pet that has been found. As per Bylaw No.20/2019 every person within the municipality who owns or keeps a dog or cat over 3 months old must obtain an animal license from the Municipal Office.

If you no longer have a previously registered pet, please contact the Town Office so we can update our records.

The Town would like to express appreciation to the responsible pet owners. As always, please remember to vaccinate your rabies and clean up after your pets.

### **2020 Utility Rates**

**2020 Utility Rates have been approved by Council and the Municipal Board.**

**Effective January 1<sup>st</sup>, 2020 utility rates, per quarter will be as follows:**

**Sewer \$151.04**

**Water \$151.04 for the first 5000 gallons, \$26.19 per gallons above that  
Minimum billing will be \$302.08**

The Town of Bruno and the R.M. of Bayne #371 would like to present a community recognition award. People can nominate whoever they think has done an outstanding job in the community. **Please remember to pay your tax accounts. All accounts in arrears will be sent to Taxervice, a tax enforcement agency. If your account is in arrears that means you will be contacted by them directly during all stages of tax enforcement. If your account is sent to Taxervice there will be a registration fee of \$330.00 that will be added to your tax account.**

Please note that we have added the Bylaw No 01/2020 **A Bylaw to Classify, Regulate, License and Govern Businesses & Business Activity**. This means in order to operate a business within the Town of Bruno you will require a business license. License will be required by:

- All persons carrying out business within the Municipality
- Direct sellers and transient traders
- Contractors
- Home based Business
- Trade show organizers

Fees will be \$50.00 per year or \$20.00 per day. A copy of the bylaw can be found at the Town Office, if you have any questions or concerns please contact the Town Office.
