To Use Curbside Pickup

Place holds on Wheatland library materials on our website Wheatland.sk.ca Materials that are available at your pickup branch will be available quickly. Materials from other branches aren't being exchanged quite yet, but you can place your holds now to get on the list. See below to find out how to limit your requests to items from Bruno Wheatland Library.

Wait for notification that your holds are ready.

Call or email your Bruno library to **schedule a pickup time**. This is the Bruno Wheatland Regional Library Branches email address: bruno.library@wheatland.sk.ca or phone **306-369-2353** during open hours.

Arrive at the library at your scheduled pickup time.

Call the library to let them know you have arrived.

Staff will package up your items in a clean bag. Wait for the library staff to place the items on the pickup table bin, and they have returned to the library before you approach.

Take your items home and enjoy!

Frequently Asked Questions

Items currently checked out from before the closure are not due back until July 15th.

We encourage patrons to bring materials back over the next few weeks so our book drops are not overwhelmed.

Returned Items will be Quarantined for 72 Hours

Branch staff will be quarantining returned items for 72 hours before checking items in. Items will not accrue any fines during the 72 hour wait period.

Loan Periods are extended

For the next little bit, you can enjoy all of our items for 4 weeks. This allows patrons who would like to quarantine items at their home if you choose.

No Fine Payments during Curbside

While we are offering curbside service we will not be accepting fine payments. We have removed the \$10 fine threshold during curbside so you can continue to order materials and pick it up.

Rediscover your Bruno Branch Collection

Initially we will be making materials from your Bruno branch available. Materials from across Wheatland will be reopening in later stages.

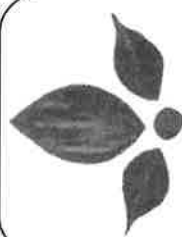

ST. AGNES PARISH – PETERSON

Sunday morning masses have resumed.

Please follow the schedule at the top of the page.

With the current required 6 feet of distance between households, **we have a 20 person limit.**

Peterson Parishioners are asked to please contact **Tania-Dauvin-Frank** to register for mass.

Due to the size of our church and the limited number of people allowed, **St. Agnes Parishioners will be given the first choice for registration for Sunday masses.**

This is with the exception of Memorial Masses.

Thanks to everyone, for your understanding during this ever changing time.

St. Agnes Parish Council

St. Bruno Parishioners:

- We are now allowed 1/3 seating capacity inside the church, up to a max of 150 people. In St. Bruno Church, 1/3 the capacity comes to approximately 110 people. Benches are marked off to respect the 6 feet of distance between households. Because of the higher numbers allowed now, we will discontinue the pre-registration of parishioners who wish to sit within the church. Ushers will assist with seating so we can accommodate all those who wish to attend mass inside the church. We ask for everyone’s patience and understanding as we proceed forward, especially if the church is full and no more seats are available for parishioners. We are doing our best to accommodate everyone, follow the guidelines and comply with the requirements in the Public Health Order.
- You are encouraged to wear a mask, if it makes you feel more safe and comfortable.
- The distribution of COMMUNION is to take place following the Mass. Fr. Pius will wear a mask and sanitize his hands immediately before and after distributing Communion. Physical contact will be avoided and Fr. Pius will sanitize his hands intermittently as necessary.
- Under watchful eyes, a stationary basket will be placed in the church for donations.
- The church will be cleaned and sanitized after each service.
- For those who wish to remain in their vehicles and listen to the weekday and Sunday morning masses on their vehicle radio at 88.5 FM, we are instructed that vehicles must be separated by at least 5 metres. Individuals are required to remain inside or within arm’s reach of their vehicles and not permitted to move to another vehicle, or sit with friends. No objects may be passed between vehicles.
- Fr. Pius will distribute Holy Communion outside after Mass. Please follow the social distancing guidelines.
