The Clayton Young Memorial Award is presented to an individual whose volunteerism has had a profound influence towards fulfilling Saskatchewan's Wildlife Federation mission statement; **to ensure the wild life legacy we leave to our children surpasses that which we inherited.**

The provincial awards are usually presented in person at the Saskatchewan Wildlife Federation annual convention, but unfortunately, due to Covid19 health restrictions this year, the winners were announced at the virtual convention on February 12, 2021. Winners will also be featured in a future issue of the Outdoor Canada West magazine.



FROM THE DESK OF THE CAO - UPDATE 2020

The year of 2020 took us all a bit by surprise – Although the Town was not able to do all the things we were hoping we did manage to accomplish a fair amount. Thank you to all our residents for their patience and adapting with us through all the Covid regulations – we will continue to strive for a safe town for our residents and look forward to the day when we can again visit freely with our families, friends and neighbours.

Here are some of the items the Town was able to complete this past year.

PUBLIC WORKS

- New cement pad in shop to replace the dirt floor
- Water Main breaks on 2nd street East and a service connection repair on 3rd st East in March 2020, Main street Water Main break in December 2020
- Hydrant replacements were done at Ursuline & Mayer Street and at Hoffman & Kirby Street
- Water treatment plant had new piping and key fob system installed
- Purchased a “newer” street sweeper

OFFICE

- Basement Renovation and first phase of creating an EMO centre
- Acquisition of a small section of land on the SE corner of Town
- Sponsor Tent for Cherry Sunday, as this event did not happen, we have carried over the sponsorship to 2021, tentative date August 8th.
- Creation of HR Manual with the help of Sagehill
- Bylaw Enforcement with B&B Enforcement Services
- Artificial Greens Donation Account set-up
- Sponsor Trade Scholarship for Bruno Central School
- Office security and new upgraded steel door (after attempted B&E in June)
- Completed REACT loan in August and Mack Truck Loan in September
- Town Maps
- Strategic Plan updated – New Vision statement
“A Community You’re Proud to Call Home
Small Town – Big Heart”

RECREATION FACILITIES

- Rink – LED lighting on Ice Surface, cement pad at North Entrance, new locks, fence for Ice Plant, new Windows.
- Golf Club – Two synthetic greens were installed in 2019/2020 through generous donations and volunteer hard work.
- Hall – New ovens & fridges.
- Purchased a “newer” Zamboni.
- Completion of conversion of Curling Rink into Archery Range and lease to Wildlife Federation

PROTECTIVE SERVICES

- 3 sets of Fire suits
- Re-certification of Tanks
- New metal roofing on fire hall

In November we said goodbye to Councillor’s Laurel Grayson and Jenna Hale – Thank you both for all your hard work! New councillors that came aboard are Michael Sorokoski and Kurtis Ellis.

Looking forward to 2021 – Some of the projects we would like to carry out include a lift station upgrade, completion of the EMO centre in the Office basement including a generator for the building, sidewalk repairs, 2 hydrant replacements, sewer line flushing, and reservoir cleaning as well as equipment and supplies updates for the Fire Department and 1st Responders. With the expectations that Covid will affect our funding these projects are all tentative at this time. 2021 is also revaluation year for SAMA which means that property values will be adjusted this year. These adjustments will affect the tax base. Council will conduct budget meetings in March with a goal of maintaining services and infrastructure while keeping tax increases in check.

Kevin has been a long-time member of the Bruno Wildlife Federation, serving in several capacities including and most currently as President of the branch. Kevin is an advocate for environmental stewardship which he role-models to his peers and youth of their community. His quiet, hard-working personality makes volunteering look effortless, as he simply gets the job done.

Kevin supports and promotes fundraising efforts such as their Annual Fish Fry and silent auction, which raises money for projects such as the purchase of wildlife lands and education and programs for youth. He has led many sell-out events which brings together people from surrounding communities to enjoy great food, fellowship and discussion regarding wildlife topics presented by quality guest speakers which Kevin arranges. He is accepting of ideas and willing to implement change.

Kevin is a skilled hunter and eagerly and willingly shares his passion with many first time and seasoned hunters. He encourages the first timers and guides them through the process from the hunt to the plate. His experience with processing wild game and sausage making is a craft that he helps others to develop.

An idea was presented at a branch meeting for the repurposing of the community curling rink into an archery range. With support of the branch Kevin took charge of the project; he took the necessary steps to work with the community, organized work groups and brought the archery range and Clubhouse for the Bruno Wildlife Federation to fruition.

Kevin knows the rules, follows them and encourages others to do the same. He leads by example and is dedicated to making a difference through his volunteerism. We are proud and grateful for his leadership in the Bruno Wildlife Federation and feel he is very deserving of the award.

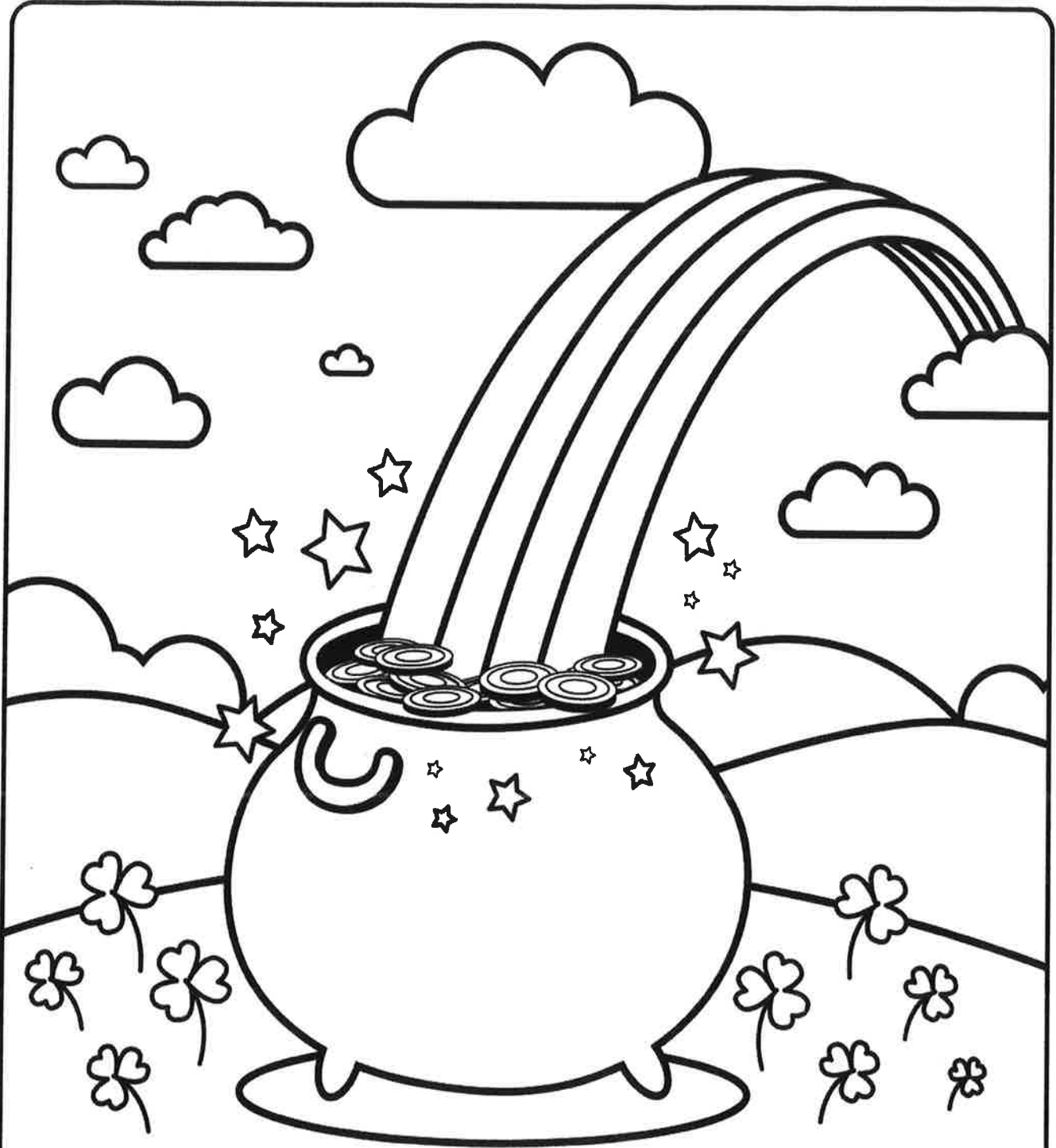
