Updates:

Due Dates for items you may have checked from the Bruno Library will continue to be extended. SILS has continued with rolling updates so due dates will continue to extend further and further until we have an opening date.

Reading fun for kids, from Canada's public libraries

About the TD Summer Reading Club Program

The TD Summer Reading Club will be moving to an **online only** program for the summer of 2020 it goes live on June 15, 2020. The theme remains "Game On," and readers and parents/guardians of pre-readers will be able to register online. Readers can choose their age category and have a virtual notebook very similar to the printed ones.

Wheatland Regional Library will be promoting and offering access to the TDSRC through Beanstack Plus.. Beanstack also offers an app to track reading so that readers of all ages can obtain rewards such as virtual badges.

Approximately 45 to 50 full text & image ebooks will be freely available to participants on the TDSRC website from June 15, 2020 until Labour Day. WRL offers a strong selection of ebooks and audio for children including Tumblebooks, Libby/Library2go, AudioBook Cloud, BookFlix, Kids InfoBits, and Hoopla. Approximately 35 prize-winning or notable science titles were added to Libby/Library2go in conjunction with the recent Earth Day celebrations.

TD Summer Reading Club is Canada's biggest, bilingual summer reading program for kids of all ages, all interests, and all abilities. This free program is co-created and delivered by more than 2,000 public libraries across Canada. It celebrates Canadian authors, illustrators and stories. It's designed to inspire kids to explore the fun of reading their way – the key to building a lifelong love of reading.



Why it's special: Kids (and their caregivers) can participate anytime, anywhere – at local public libraries across Canada as well as at home, online, on the road or wherever their summer takes them.

Participants explore recommended reads; track their own reading; connect and share with others across the country; read books online; join in activities; collect reading incentives; write jokes, stories and book reviews, and more. There are great resources for kids with print disabilities as well as for pre-readers and their families.

- Parishioners who have come to park in the church parking lot, to listen to Mass on their vehicle radios, (88.5 FM) are welcome to receive COMMUNION after mass as well. An outside station will be set up where Fr. Pius will be available to distribute Holy Communion.

Please follow the social distancing guidelines.

- St. Bruno parishioners can register their name with Victor Granger @ 306 – 369-4193, if they would like to attend mass inside the church. Consideration will be given to those who have not had the opportunity to be inside the church. Victor will keep track of who has attended, by referring to our updated Parish Family List.

Please feel free to call Fr. Pius @ 306-369-2235 if you have any questions or concerns.

Parish updates and announcements will be posted on the St. Bruno Parish Facebook page, as changes outlined by the government occur.

Parishioners are now welcome to attend mass, following the proposed guidelines:

- Only 10 people (including the priest) are permitted to gather inside the church. (Until further notice)
- Couples or families from the same household may sit together. Social distancing of at least 6 feet of space between individuals must be followed.
- You are encouraged to wear a mask, if it makes you feel more safe and comfortable.
- The distribution of COMMUNION is to take place following the Mass. Fr. Pius will wear a mask and sanitize his hands immediately before and after distributing Communion. Physical contact will be avoided and Fr. Pius will sanitize his hands intermittently as necessary.
- Under watchful eyes, a stationary basket will be placed in the church for donations.
- The church will be cleaned and sanitized after each service.

Limit or postpone gatherings



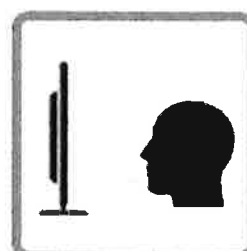
