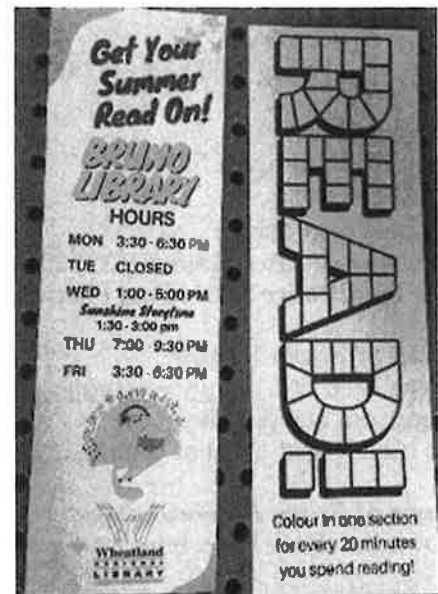

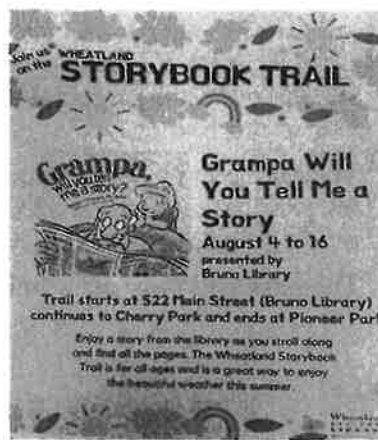

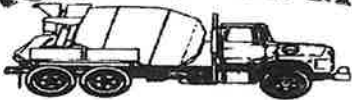

Please be sure to trim your trees and bushes around municipal roadways, alleyways and sidewalks.

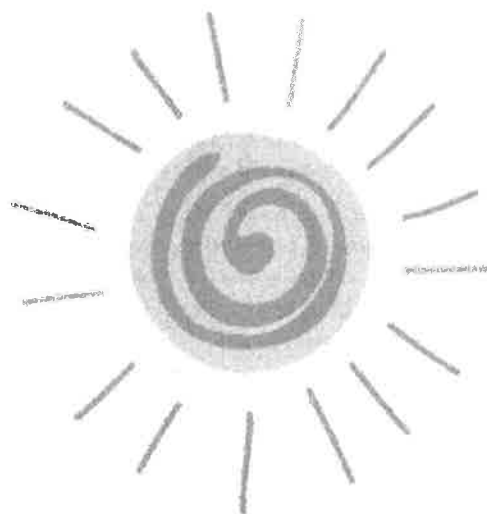
It is your responsibility as the property owner / tenant to ensure your trees stay on your property so please check yours and trim accordingly.

SASKPOWER WOOD POLE INSPECTIONS

There are over 1.2 million wood power poles throughout Saskatchewan. To help ensure safe and reliable power, we conduct annual wood pole inspections to look for damage and decay and carry out maintenance to extend the life of the poles.

WHAT ARE WE DOING?

This year, SaskPower contractors will be inspecting almost 97,000 wood power poles and conducting overhead transformer ground grid testing at over 8,200 rural locations throughout the province. Wildfire protection will also be installed on 2,000 poles in selected lines in the forested area in the La Ronge district.



We're looking for damage, signs of decay and carpenter ant infestation.

Where we can, we repair or reinforce the pole to extend its life and keep it in service. If we can't repair or reinforce it, the pole will be replaced.

We won't need to disrupt your power to get this work done.

HEALTH AND SAFETY

Our top priority is to ensure your health and safety, and the health and safety of our crews, while maintaining reliable power.

The contractor for this work is Central Pole Inspections and Maintenance Inc. Crews will stay within the SaskPower right-of-way as much as possible, but may occasionally need access to your property. They will wear high-visibility clothing and carry identification with them. Their vehicles will be marked with their company logo.
