ST. THERESE NEWS

The St. Therese chapel needs a new roof.

You may remember that St. Therese Institute began campaigning in 2015 for new roofs for this erstwhile Ursuline convent where we operate. The two biggest roofing projects were on our east wing, with our gym, and on the Old Main building. Today these are both done. Two years ago, our staff and volunteers also formed a crew to put a new roof on the AD1977 section of our west wing.

This June, we need to finish the final phase of roofing. Left to complete are those roofs on the AD1953 section of our compound, which is the chapel and that section of the west wing directly behind it. These roofs were leaking last summer, so it is time for action.

The St. Therese Institute announces a capital campaign to raise \$70,000 for the work in June. The great news is that, if our support community can raise half of it, one generous family has pledged to cover the other \$35,000! Counting the matching pledge, we currently have 75% of our funds.

Help us finish the challenge! If you have fond connections to the Ursuline Academy or if you appreciate the ways that St. Therese blesses our community today, ensure this great legacy in Bruno with your contribution to the "Chapel Roof Capital Campaign".

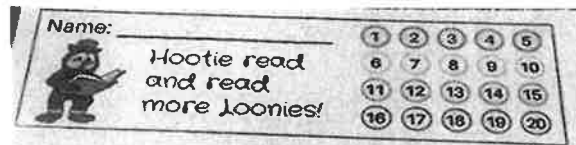

Collect them and then cash them in for prizes. Prizes are on a first come basis and may vary from week to week. So check the library out often and see what's new in prizes and books.

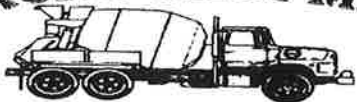
