

**TOWN OF BRUNO**

**BYLAW # 03/2016**

**A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF BRUNO, IN THE PROVINCE OF SASKATCHEWAN FOR; THE PROHIBITING OF THE BURNING OF GARBAGE OR WASTE MATERIAL, THE USE OF FIRE PITS, THE PROVISION OF THE BRUNO & DISTRICT VOLUNTEER FIRE DEPARTMENT SERVICES AND FIRE BANS WITHIN THE TOWN BOUNDARIES**

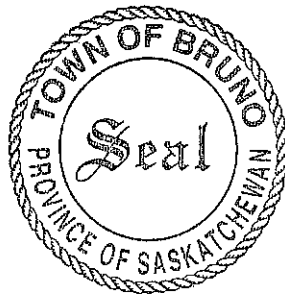
The Council of the Town of Bruno in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. The burning of garbage, leaf litter, compost or flammable material is prohibited in the Town of Bruno.
2. Any fire pits, etc. used for the purpose of backyard barbecues, wiener roast, etc are to be:
  - (a) in a properly constructed brick or metallic burner, no greater than 2.5 feet in diameter and covered with a suitable 1/8 inch wire mesh.
  - (b) situated a minimum of 10 feet away from any building or structure.
  - (c) burn only clean wood.
  - (d) under constant supervision and have some form of fire extinguisher on site.
3. Council and or the Mayor and or the Fire Chief or next in command to the Fire Chief can declare a fire ban within Town limits where there is to be no fire pit usage, open fires, fireworks and no lit Sky Lanterns and;
  - (b) rescind a fire ban by means of the onset of rain or if a fire risk has passed.
4. Covered propane and coal barbeques are permitted during a fire ban but must be under constant supervision and have some form of fire extinguisher on site, no open flames or paper or wood barbeques.
5. A person who violates or fails to comply with any of the provision of this bylaw is guilty of an offense and liable on summary conviction to the penalties set out below:
  - (a) First offense- \$100.00
  - (b) Second Offense - \$200.00
  - (c) Third or subsequent offenses – not less than \$200.00 and not more than \$2,000.00
  - (d) Fines under 5(a) or 5(b) shall be discounted to the sum of \$75.00 for a first offense and \$150.00 for a second offense if paid within 14 calendar days of the date of the notice of bylaw violation.
  - (e) Lighting of a fire during a fire ban, a violator is subject to fines under 5(a) to 5(d) and;

- (i) in the event that Fire Department services are required to attend and or extinguish a fire during a fire ban as a result of fire from a fire pit or open fire; the violator is to be charged for that service as per the fees laid out in Appendix "B" of the Town of Bruno Mutual Aid Agreement and;
  - (ii) in the event that the Fire Department services are required to attend to any other violation of the bylaw the violator is to be charged for that service as per the fees laid out in Appendix "B" of the Town of Bruno Mutual Aid Agreement.
6. The Fire Chief and the Bruno & District Volunteer Fire Department in itself have powers to act on behalf of the Municipality its residents and businesses and to any Mutual Aid Agreements as legislated within the Fire and Safety Act 2015.
7. Bylaws 08/2010 and 13/96 are repealed.
8. This bylaw shall come into force on the day of its final passing.
