

## BRUNO FIRE DEPARTMENT NEWS

Can we find you in an emergency? In town, the number on your house should always be clearly visible. In rural areas, there are Range Road and Township Road numbers. Ensure everyone on your farm knows the directions to your location. These steps increase safety for your family and neighbours. Test your Carbon Monoxide (CO) detector twice a year. Carbon monoxide is colourless, odourless and deadly. Your alarm must be working to keep you safe. Press the button on your detector today, and replace the batteries if needed. Check the manufacturer's date, as they need to be replaced every 5-7 years. Signs of CO poisoning are headaches, dizziness, nausea and confusion.

## ST. THERESE NEWS

Halloween is the vigil of the great Catholic November 1st feast of All Saints.

The name Halloween comes from the English cultural heritage (which happens to be my own) in which we called the Solemnity of All Saints "All Hallowed's Day". A solemnity is the highest level of feast on the Catholic liturgical calendar. In antique English, a saintly soul is called "hallowed" in the same sense that we still use "hallowed be Thy name" in our traditional translation of the line the Our Father prayer.

In Catholic parlance, a religious observance that spans three days is called a "triduum". The Easter Triduum of Good Friday, Holy Saturday, and Easter Sunday is the most famous version of this, but the month of November also begins with a triduum - the Triduum of All Saints. That is, All Hallowed's Eve (Halloween), the Solemnity of All Saints, and the feast of All Souls, on October 31st, November 1st, and November 2nd, respectively.

Over the centuries, Catholics have tended to fast and pray on the vigil evening before a Solemnity. We have gotten to the point of doing pretty much the opposite on All Hallowed's Eve, but if you know the Catholic worldview, it is easy to see why. The folk celebrations of Halloween - with its skeletons, devils, and the choice of treats instead of "tricky" punishments - grow up very naturally alongside the themes of the liturgical feasts we celebrate officially.

On Halloween, we are thumbing our noses at hell. Before we move on to celebrating heaven on November 1 and praying for human souls in purgatory on November 2, we have a "nah-nah-na-boo-boo" at the devil on Halloween.

Before we were Christians, we lived in terror of the devils. Most cultures even instituted some form of human blood sacrifice to placate the mysterious powers that seem to hold our lives in forms of suffering - crop failures, bad luck in war, bad luck in love, and so on. God's revelation to mankind showed us that, in fact, the devils had enslaved us through sin, which is what leads to the bad things that all find their crescendo in the spectre of death and oblivion. We remember their courage, service and sacrifice at home, around the world and across generations.







## Building Permit Process

### Question?

Why is the building permit process essential for property owners undertaking new construction or additions and what are the typical steps involved in obtaining a building permit for a new house or addition?

### Answer:

As per *The Construction Codes Act* (CC Act), a building owner must obtain a valid building permit prior to commencing work on a building. In addition to satisfying this legislative requirement, there are several benefits to obtaining a building permit:

- **Peace of Mind:** Owner receives an independent third-party review by a licensed building official which provides assurance the building is safe, healthy and habitable and in compliance with the construction standards.
- **Mortgage and Insurance Coverage:** Having a valid building permit is often a requirement to obtain or maintain a mortgage or insurance on a building.
- **Record Retention:** The local authority is required to retain the records (including the approved drawings) which can be invaluable if a fire occurs in the building or when planning future alterations.

The typical building permit process for a new house or addition is as follows:



### Permits are required for

- All new home or secondary building construction (Sheds, Garages, Gazebo, Quonset, etc)
- Removal/replacement of interior walls.
- Washroom additions
- Basement renovations
- addition of windows, skylights, or doors.
- Decks/verandas/patios
- Any other exterior additions to existing home or structures


