The tabs from your pop and other cans are a clean source of aluminum that take up little space, and add up to dollars.

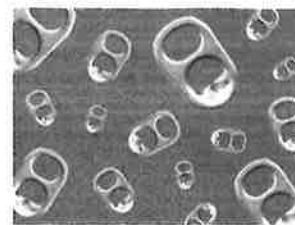
Where does the money go?

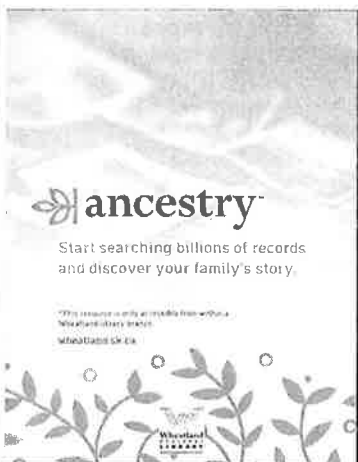


TumbleBookLibrary is a curated database of children's e-books, available through Public Libraries around the world.
