THE ADMINISTRATOR (CAO) IS THE HEAD OF STAFFING AND DELEGATES THE DECISIONS OF COUNCIL THE ADMINISTRATOR & STAFF ADMINISTER THESE DECISION OF COUNCIL WHETHER THEY AGREE OR NOT. IT IS THE STAFF'S JOB TO CARRY OUT COUNCIL DECISIONS.

DECISIONS OF COUNCIL ARE MADE AS A GROUP WITH MAJORITY VOTE RULING. ONE COUNCILOR (OR MAYOR) CAN NOT MAKE A DECISION WITHOUT DISCUSSION AND VOTING BY THE GROUP. ALL COUNCIL (MAYOR) DOES NOT HAVE TO AGREE ON THE DECISION BUT THEY DO HAVE TO SUPPORT AND UPHOLD THE DECISION OF THE MAJORITY.
