Butterflies at the Library!

This spring, we are raising butterflies! We bought eight larvae and a butterfly house. We will set up a great experience for our youngest patrons. The Butterfly Abode includes caterpillars, a butterfly house, magnifying glasses, observation forms, some butterfly decorations, signage with butterfly facts and books from our collection about butterflies. When kids come into the library, they can observe the caterpillars, chrysalis, or butterflies — depending on the stage of metamorphosis.. After they have made their observations and talked about facts and processes, they can draw or write about what they see and post their observations on our library wall for others to read. This center is different each time the patron comes in since the butterflies are progressing through their metamorphosis. Once all the caterpillars have become butterflies, we will invite patrons to their release into Bruno and the world! The butterfly station creates a sense of wonder and discovery in children. It offers kids and caregivers the chance to talk and learn new words like chrysalis and metamorphosis, write or draw what they see and read to learn more about butterflies.

Introduction

The Water Security Agency and the Ministry of Environment requires that at least once each year waterworks owners provide notification to consumers of the quality of water produced and supplied as well as information on the performance of the waterworks in submitting samples as required by a Minister's Order or Permit to Operate a waterworks. The following is a summary of the Town of Bruno water quality and sample submission compliance record for the 2023 calendar year. This report was completed March 25, 2024. A minimum of 0.1 milligrams per litre (mg/L) free chlorine residual is required for water entering the distribution system. Tests are normally performed on a daily basis by the waterworks operator and are to be recorded in operation records. The roll is open for a period of 60 days during the revaluation year. During this time you may come to the office to inspect any assessment on our roll. You may also appeal your assessment or someone else's.

WHAT TO DO IF YOU WANT TO APPEAL YOUR ASSESSMENT

If you want appeal your assessment, you need to send your appeal to the Board of Revision. The R.M. of Bayne has enlisted Western Municipal Consulting to hear all appeals. A fee of \$250, payable to the R.M. of Bayne No. 371, must accompany each parcel you wish to appeal.

It is important to note that you cannot appeal an assessment based on your taxes going up. If you feel an error has been made, you may appeal this and include specifications of the error. You must provide a summary of supporting facts to back up your appeal. The form to appeal is on the back of your notice of assessment.



Definition of Golf Cart:

A self-propelled vehicle with 3 or more wheels that:

- **Is designed to carry golfers and their equipment**
- **Cannot exceed 24 KM per hr**
- **Weighs less than 590 kgs**
- **Is not defined as an all terrain vehicle in the All Terrain Vehicles Act or a low-speed vehicle in the Motor Vehicle Safety Regulations**

Rules for Operation

(as set out in conjunction with SGI)

- **Must carry \$200,000 liability insurance**
- **Minimum Class 7 License required by driver**
- **Slow Moving Sign required**
- **Obey traffic laws & speed limits**

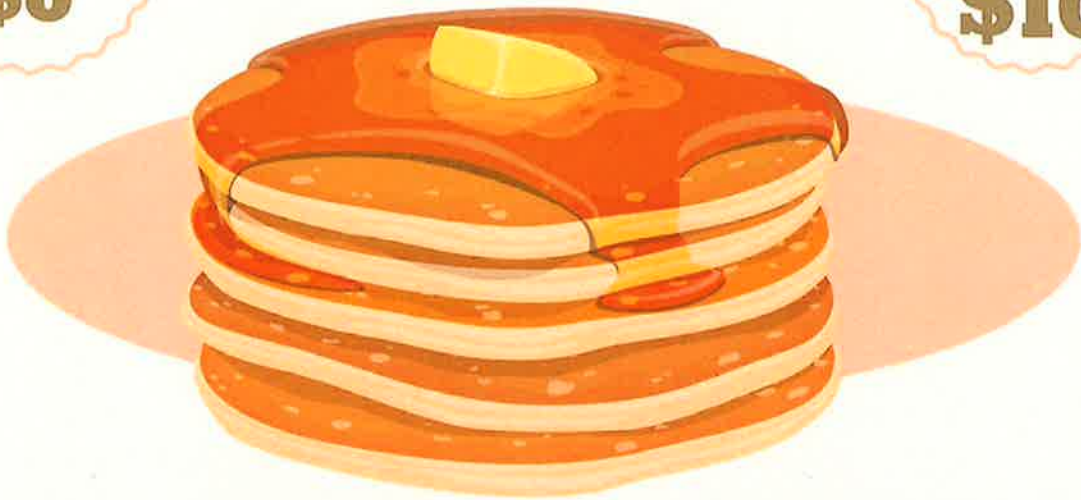

ANNUAL VEGETATION MANAGEMENT PROGRAM

Each year, CN is required to manage vegetation on its right-of-way. Managing this vegetation contributes to mitigating fire risks and enhances the efficiency of inspection of track infrastructure.

To ensure safe railway operations, CN will conduct its annual vegetation control program on its rail lines in the province of Saskatchewan. A certified professional (Davey Tree Expert Company of Canada, Ltd., 1-800-465-6367) will be applying herbicides on and around the railway tracks (primarily along the 24-foot graveled area/ballast). All product requirements for setbacks in the vicinity of dwellings, aquatic environments, and municipal water supplies will be met.

CN only uses herbicides that have been approved for use in Canada and in the province within which they are applied.

The program is expected to take place from May to October 2025.

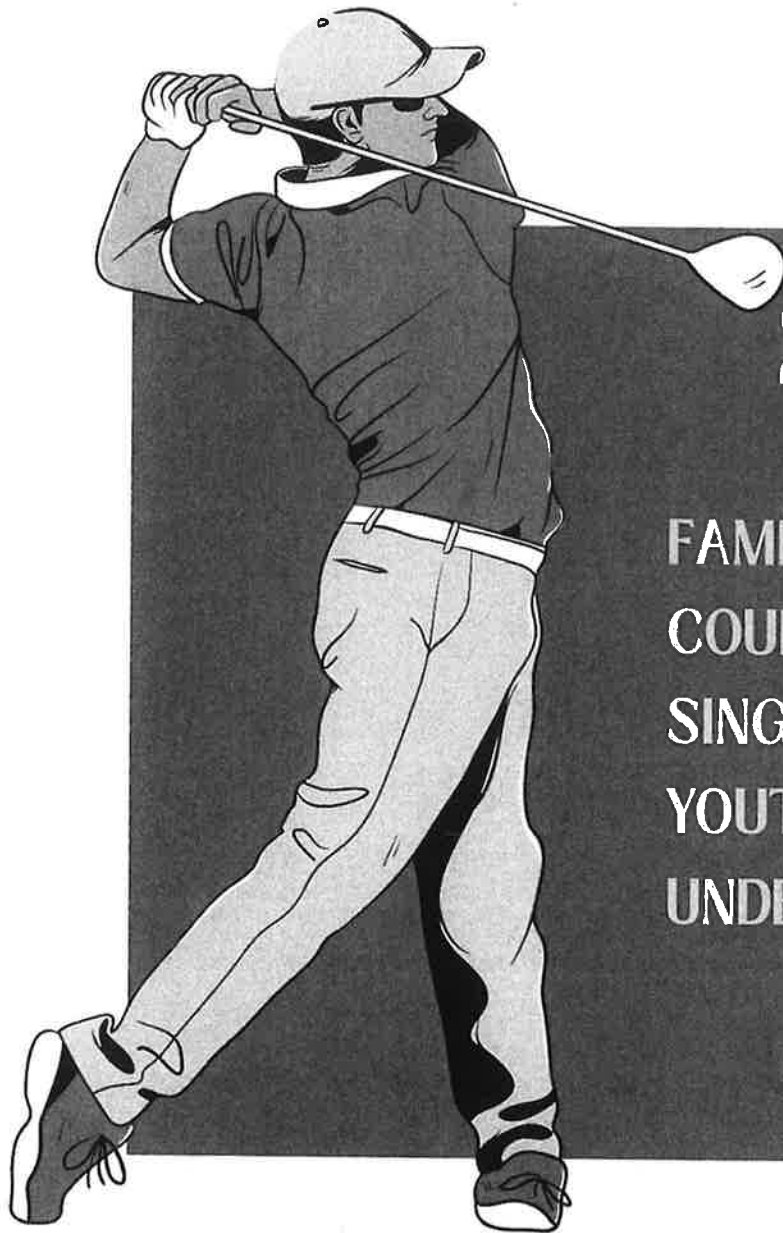
