ST. THERESE NEWS

Dear Friends and Neighbors,

The St. Therese Institute loves the town of Bruno, where our mission has grown as a source of life ever since we moved into the old Ursuline convent eighteen years ago. Having undergone some staffing and programming change this past year, we have had occasion to reflect on some of the good that has been done over these years. It's worth sharing!

If you are Catholic, you might be interested that our alumni include 4 priests, 2 seminarians, and 12 discerned male or female religious (6 of whom have progressed to the point of taking vows) within its ranks. On the other hand, we hear the contemporary Church call for a vibrant new vision for the lay-person in our times. At the institute we teach St. Therese of Lisieux's vision of the priestly and prophetic character of EVERY baptized person's life and work (no matter how "menial" any life or career may seem). For this reason, we especially celebrate the many vocations to married life which have come from our mission. Strong Catholic marriage is the most crucial social remedy for our hurting world. Everything else - including the good priests - comes from this primary foundation.

We would never claim St. Therese is the sole reason for any good demographic trends in town, but St. Therese certainly has a part in the positive story of Bruno's census numbers. The population of Bruno had declined 13.3% in five years between 2001 and 2006. The 2006 census lists Bruno's population at 495. St. Therese came to town in 2007, and by our most recent 2021 census numbers, we have seen a 22% population increase to 604 since then. There are also more total residences now, and there are higher overall occupancy rates.

St. Therese draws people here from British Columbia to Prince Edward Island and every manner of place in between. A St. Bruno parish men's group I belong to brainstormed how many local households we could identify in Bruno now who are here for reasons connected to the St. Therese Institute. We came close to forty (my wife and I brought our own family of nine from Minnesota). These things impact everything from the Main Street foot traffic keeping businesses open to the property taxes keeping the quality of our services high. Throw in all the people who come to Bruno from far and wide for conferences in the winter and youth events in the summer; add the Cherry Festival and the St. Therese orchards that help make Bruno the Cherry Town of the Prairies; there is a lot here to celebrate.

There is also a hitch. We need investment. St. Therese is engaged in an overhaul of our operation fundamentals to keep our business model sustainable. We can do this ourselves, but we also live in a large old historic building with dozens of acres of grounds that will require a full overhaul too...and sooner rather than later. Our business model alone will never generate funds for this kind of normal, but major, renewal. The future of the institute in Bruno needs the community - especially the Catholic community - to partner with us as capital fund donors.

If you have the means to support building renovations with a large donation that could keep this unique mission in town for coming generations, please reach out to me for a discussion or consider leaving a bequest in your will.

RV, Boat and Trailer Storage




