**RV, Boat & Trailer Storage**

Please note the Town of Bruno does offer this service free of charge but you **must register your vehicles with the Town Office**. Due to liability insurance we are required to know who each vehicle belongs to. Failure to register your vehicle may result in it being towed. Thank you to all those who have already filled out their registration.

Please remember 2021 taxes are due by **December 31st, 2021**. Council has authorized the use of a Tax Enforcement company and all accounts in arrears will be forwarded to them. If your account is forwarded to TaXervice, there will be extra fees and charges that will occur. Be sure your payments are received by or before December 31st to avoid these further charges.

***Attention Utility Customers***

Please be aware that beginning in 2022, the Town of Bruno will discontinue using individual residential door notices for final warning on overdue utility accounts.

All accounts are due within 30 days of the meter being read.

Overdue notices will be mailed or emailed on accounts overdue by more than 45 days.

Accounts in arrears by more than 45 days may be subject to disconnection without further notice.
