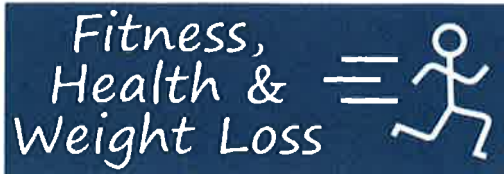

utility rates per quarter will be as follows:

Sewer \$166.14

Water \$166.14 for the first 5000 gallons, \$28.81 per 1000 gallons above that,

Minimum billings will be \$ 332.28

Water deposits for new accounts will increase to \$300.00 January 1st, 2020

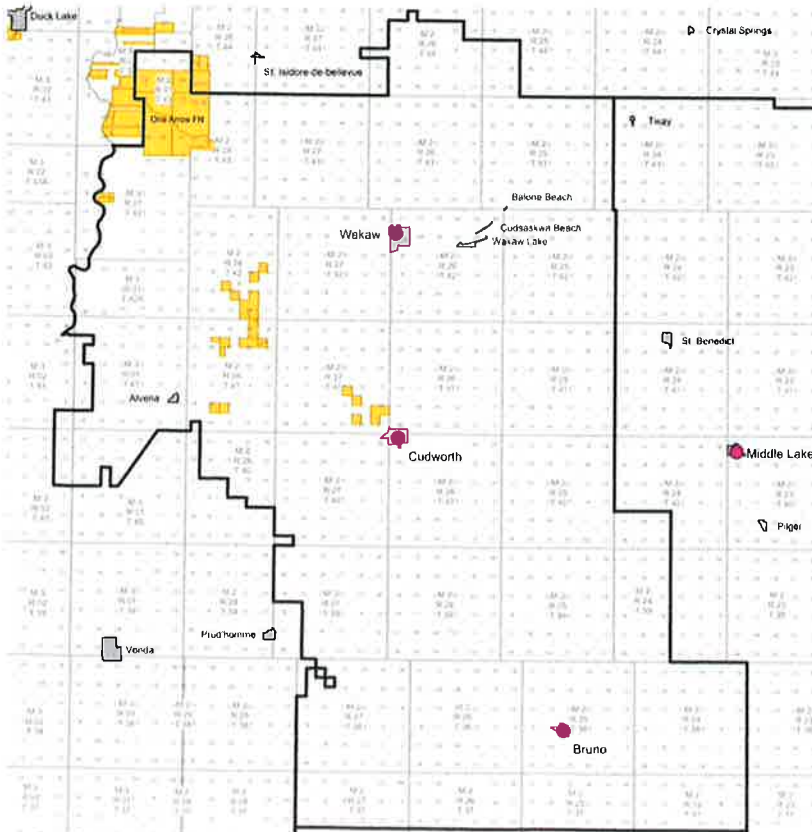

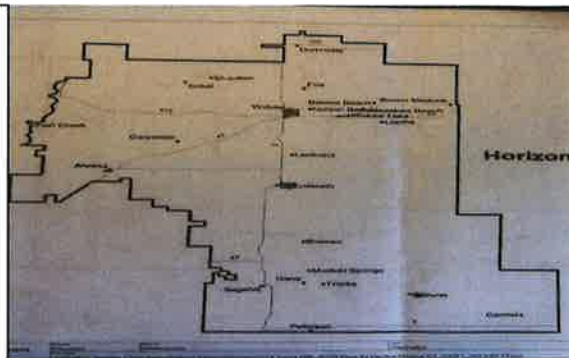

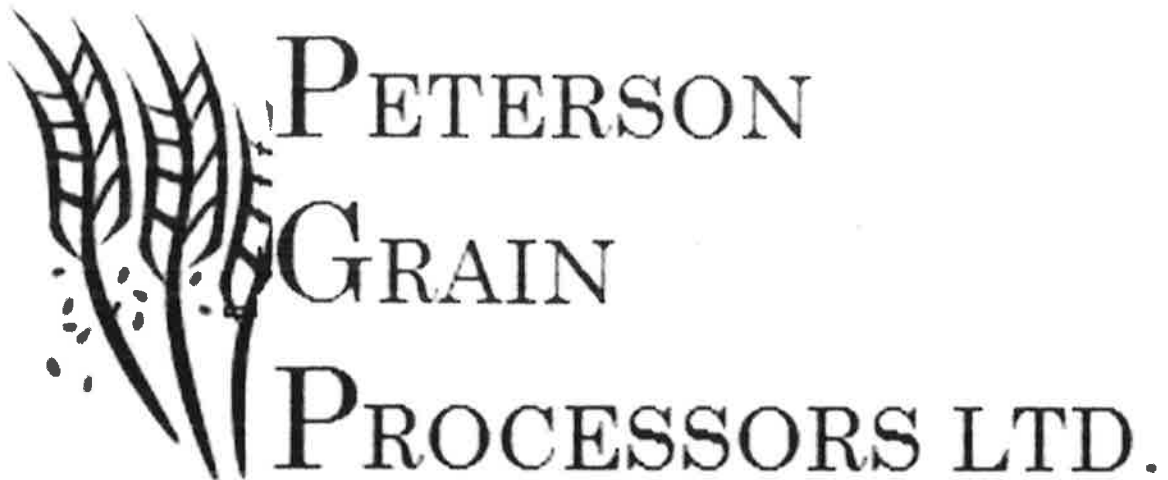
