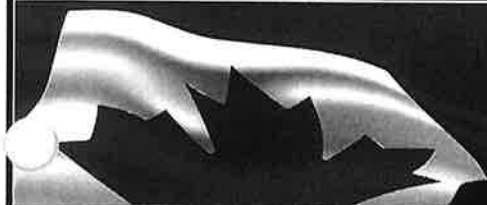

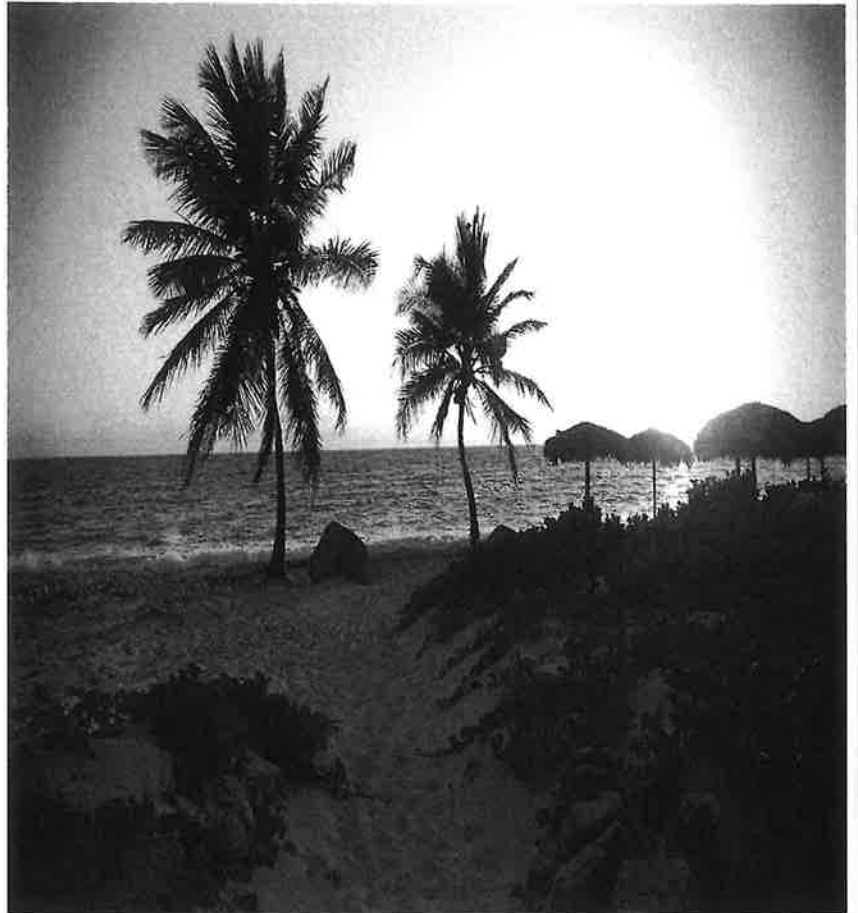

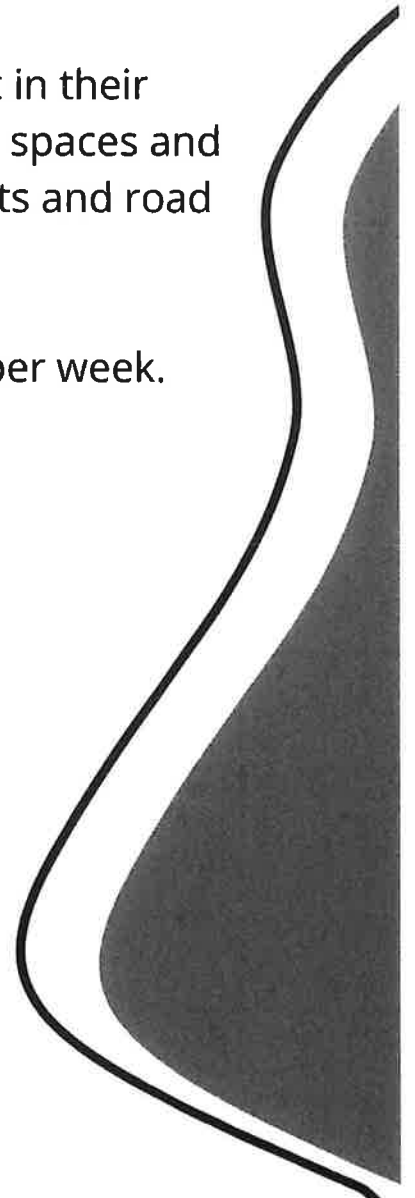

Programming

In 2024, Central offered 11 regional programs, sent out five different Take & Make Kits, and hosted five events with special guests and organizations.

Bruno

The Bruno Library received programming kits for the branch staff to run the following programs: Watercolour Art, Seashell Art, Valentine's Storytime & Craft, Galaxy Jars, Spring Storytime & Craft, Remember When, Camp Half-Blood, and Family Astronaut Camp. In September, your branch hosted Teepee Teachings with Jasmyn Albert as part of the Truth and Reconciliation Speaker Series. Over the summer, we ran the Wheatland Reading Cup Community Challenge and the TD Summer Reading Club. In the two months, the Bruno Library logged 31,927 reading minutes! In addition to in-branch programming, we sent out a total of 104 Take & Make Kits to your branch.
