TOWN OF BRUNO BYLAW 03/2025

A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF BRUNO TO CONTROL THE GROWING OF TREES, HEDGES OR SHRUBS ON PRIVATE LAND

The council of the Town of Bruno in the province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

- No person may plant, maintain or keep any hedge, shrub or tree which interferes with the intended use and operation of any sidewalk, road, street, sign, street light, utility or public works
- 2) No person shall by means of a hedge, shrub or tree hinder, prevent or obstruct access by the Fire Department to any fire hydrant located on a street or public place.
- 3) The Town of Bruno maintains no records of tree, hedge or shrub ownership on any Town lands, privately or publicly held. All trees, hedges and shrubs are considered naturally occurring and are the responsibility of each property owner to maintain or remove as they see fit. The Town of Bruno bears no cost for maintenance or removal.

This Bylaw shall come into force upon approval of the final reading and adoption of this Bylaw.
