ST. THERESE NEWS

Dear Neighbors,

St. Therese Institute's cherry orchards are cherished by the Bruno community. We help make Bruno the "Cherrytown of the Prairies", and of course we host the Cherry Festival each year on our grounds, which has become one of our town's best cultural events. You may not know, however, that the orchards put a major strain on the St. Therese Institute. People come for U-pick cherries each year, but outside these relatively small numbers, we have no market for the many cherries that remain. Worse, if we could find a market, St. Therese Institute would still not have a staff for management, for harvesting, and for marketing, transport, and sales. Neither do we have commercial equipment to harvest effectively. We struggle to staff our core operations, much less orchards.

You may know that professional orchard managers rented and operated the orchards until recently. You may not know that they left last year because they did not find the orchards viable. The orchards were originally planted in such a way that the trees are too close and the rows too narrow, making it difficult to use commercial machinery in them.

We hope to keep cherry orchards in Bruno, but we need Bruno's help to do it.

I have gone to the town council to describe our situation, to invite community dialogue.

I am also working to alleviate the problem of not enough people harvesting cherries with a combination of (1) cutting down some trees to thin the orchard and reduce output, and then (2) also seeking some creative partnerships for getting cherries picked. Last year we had folks from a Mennonite colony come pick, in exchange for meat. This year, I'm also working to develop partnerships with local sports teams as a community-building initiative: St. Therese donates all the cherries the teams can pick. They sell the cherries as a fundraiser to pay for equipment and other expenses. Of course, we will continue to run the U-Pick operation.

I need more expertise in orchard management. If you have experience in pruning, pest control, or general orchard maintenance, any help you could volunteer would be invaluable. Call 369-2555 and ask for David Douglas. Let's discuss ideas.

I also need investment. Any labor I have to provide to orchard work is a resource I can't afford. The same is true of any expenses for pesticides, orchard equipment, advertising for u-pick, signage for the public access to the orchard, and so on.

We need to find 100 people who care about keeping Bruno's cherry orchards to invest in the initiative by becoming monthly donors to St. Therese Institute. The orchard budget needs \$20,000 per year. 100 donors giving between \$15 and \$25 per month can create that. Our community identity is intertwined with these cherries. We need the community to help keep them going. Whether through volunteering, fundraising, or sponsorship, let's work together to keep Bruno the "Cherrytown of the Prairies" for years to come!

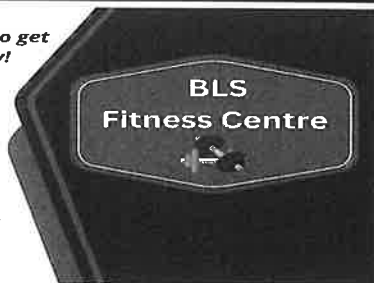

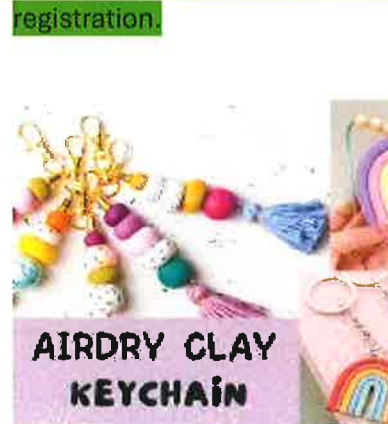

Crafty Creations: Clay Charms – ages 10-18 Program.

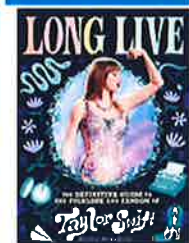
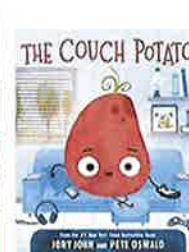
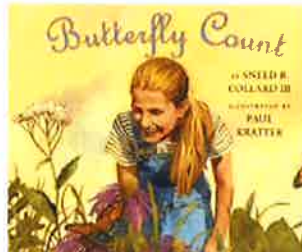
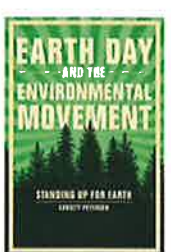
