### Cherries Are Here!

The St. Therese Institute U-Pick is now open — come and gather fresh cherries while they last! Whether you're planning to enjoy them now or stock your freezer for the year ahead, it's the perfect time to pick.

### Where to Pick

Only the back orchard is open for U-pick this season. Access it from the east edge of the cemetery. To begin, stop by the front door of the St. Therese Institute at 650 Ursuline Ave to pick up your cherry pails. From there, follow the marked walking trail around the east side of the building — it's a pleasant five-minute walk to the orchard. Bring the whole family, or bring a date!
