Faster Internet and Fines Free

We are very excited to announce that our branch will be getting faster internet speeds! As before, our internet is funded by the Ministry of Education on CommunityNet (or CNET for short). Sasktel will be upgrading the library's internet over the next few months.

Fines are now officially turned off for any material checked out from a Wheatland branch. The fines are controlled by **where the items are borrowed from**, in our case a Wheatland Branch.

Important to know is that if you as a patron physically use a branch at another agency who still chooses to charge fines you will see overdue fines on any materials you borrow from that branch. This only applies to materials that are borrowed at that library branch. (For example, if a patron goes to Duck Lake Library and checks out materials those items would get overdue fines. However if they check the same item out at the Bruno Wheatland Regional library it would be fines free). Currently Wapiti, JMCPL (Prince Albert), and Lakeland still charge over dues. All other libraries in the province are going fines free in 2021.

On the topic of Processing fees, Wheatland Regional Library is continuing to work with provincial committees on what is happening with new Processing fees. At this time new processing fees will still appear.

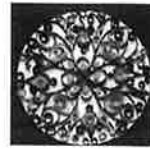

2021 Utility Rates

**2021 utility rates have been approved by Council and the Municipal Board
Effective January 1, 2021. Utility rates per quarter will be as follows:**

Sewer \$166.14

Water \$166.14 for the first 5000 gallons, \$22.14 per 1000 gallons above that.

Minimum Billing per quarter will be \$332.28

Notice to Businesses: All business licenses expire January 1st of each year. Please be sure to renew your business license by coming into the Town Office or call us for contactless payment options 306-369-2514. Business licenses are required in order to operate a business within the Town of Bruno. Licenses will be required by:

- ⇒ All persons carrying out business within the Municipality
- ⇒ Direct sales and transient traders
- ⇒ Contractors
- ⇒ Home based businesses
- ⇒ Trade show organizers

Fees are \$50.00 a year or \$20.00 per day, for a copy of this bylaw or if you have any questions or concerns please contact the Town Office.

Reminder to Residents:

Please **do not** place any sort of poison outside your homes for pest animals. If you notice signs of a pest animal on your property please alert the Town Office, we will notify the proper authorities and have the animal removed accordingly.

Please remember when you use poison it may not be ingested by your target animal, small children and domestic pets are also at risk. The Town of Bruno does not recommend the use of any type of poison within Town limits.
