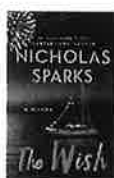

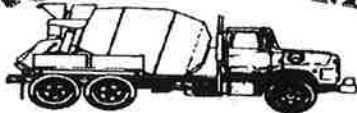

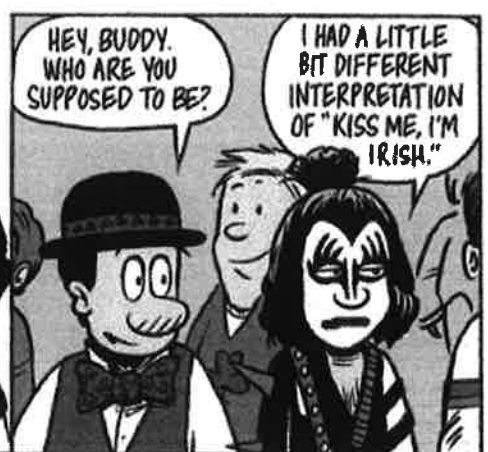

FROM THE DESK OF THE CAO - UPDATE 2021

Another year of ever changing regulations, Thank you to all our residents for their patience and adapting with us throughout Covid – we will continue to strive for a safe town for our residents and look forward to the day when we can again visit freely with our families, friends and neighbours.

Here are some of the items the Town was able to complete this past year.

PUBLIC WORKS

- Welcomed Clinton to the team in January of 2021.
- Purchased “newer” Backhoe at the end of March 2021
- Service connection repair on Gardner Street in March
- Lift Station upgrades which include a new building, underground power and gas services and new rail system for the pumps is ongoing. While carrying out these upgrades we also put in new sewage valves in the lagoon. These upgrade came with a price tag of over \$100,000.00. Thankfully, we were successful in getting funding to pay for almost \$88,000.00 of those costs.
- Replaced Hydrants on Hoffman Avenue beside the Rink and on Kirby street at Hoffman corner
- Sidewalks were replaced on Main Street in front of the Café and a residential section on 3rd Street
- Water reservoir cleaning by Robotic drone.
- Sewer lines were flushed to ensure proper flow
- Security system installed at Water Treatment Plant
- IPAD purchased to make water reading easier and faster.
- Mobile Speed Sign and speed bumps installed for traffic control

OFFICE

- Basement Renovation complete. Waiting on a generator for the building. Because of this delay we offered the use of the basement to the Playschool group for this year only.
- Sponsored Tent for Cherry Sunday
- Bylaw Enforcement with B&B Enforcement Services continues
- Started donation account and ran successful fundraisers to save the Old Fire Hall – back wall in need of repair. We have raised over \$4000.00 for this project. We also have had numerous people come forward with bricks that we can use for the repairs which will help keep our costs down.
- Sponsor Trade Scholarship for Bruno Central School
- New server installed for the computer system
- New Table and Chairs for the Council Chamber
- Fence erected on South End of Town for upcoming Mural project
- Had a streetlight added at Grid Road/Runge Street corner

- Rink – Complete Kitchen renovation carried out through continued donations to the Artificial Ice fund.
- Rink – Security system installed
- Golf Club – Hole #5 synthetic green installed
- Golf Club – Clubhouse deck, new picnic tables.

- Hall – Complete interior painting
- Library – Window Repairs
- First step in creation of dog park on the South East corner of Town
- Power pedestals installed in Pioneer Park

ST. BRUNO PARISH IS LOOKING FOR NEW CEMETERY AND GROUNDS KEEPERS

Many, many THANKS to Rudy and Joyce Meyer, who have been doing this job for several years. You both did an excellent job with the maintenance of our Parish Church grounds, and we will miss the meticulous work that you did, to keep everything looking so beautiful and clean. Enjoy your well deserved retirement and may God bless you both with good health and happiness in the years ahead.

Presently, the General Duties involved with this job for the St. Bruno Parish Cemetery and Grounds is as follows:

1. In spring, when the weather permits and snow is gone, pine cones in the old part of the Cemetery need to be raked, including the pathways, Grotto area, and all the tree lines up to St. Therese property. The debris is piled up and hauled away.
2. Use a leaf blower 2-3 times in the summer to keep the pathways in cemetery cleared off.
3. Cut down dead trees, remove this wood, haul limbs and clean up debris.
4. Prune trees, haul away and dispose or have the Town of Bruno chip them up.
(Need own chain saws, pole saw, hedge trimmer and leaf blower)
5. Spray weeds – will need to use hand sprayer in some areas
6. Weed spraying in larger areas, will need to use a pull behind sprayer and you can use the parish utility tractor. You are responsible to buy the chemical needed. (Curtail, Round-Up, Ally, etc.). The cost of the chemicals will be re-imbursed, as long as original bills are submitted to the parish.
7. Cut all the grass in the parish cemetery and surrounding grounds of the church and rectory. Will need to use a push lawn mower in the old parts of the cemetery, and the parish's Zero turn lawn mower can be used for the larger areas.
8. Fill in "sink holes" on the graves, and landscape around them.
9. When it is suitable to do so, plant grass in these areas.
10. Straighten out the headstones that are leaning. Replace dirt where they are sinking in, etc.
11. Plant and maintain flowers in front of the Rectory.
12. Also pull weeds by hand, in the flower beds and the cemetery area where needed.
13. Keep the Grotto scrubbed and cleaned throughout the summer, as needed and especially for the Corpus Christi Sunday procession.
14. Repair and maintain the zero turn Cub Cadet lawn mower.
(Oil, belts, hubs, pullup, sharpen blades, etc.)
15. Repair and maintain the Deutz Tractor & Farm King finishing mower
(Grease, oil, sharpen blades, belts, etc.)
16. In October, general raking and clean up of all the grounds before freeze up if possible.
17. In October, all equipment is pressure washed, oil changed, greased, put into shed for winter storage. All batteries are unhooked for winter storage.

URSULINE SISTERS CEMETERY GROUNDS

St. Bruno Parish, has been entrusted by the Ursuline Sisters to upkeep and maintain this property. We will be accepting separate tenders for this, as expenses are kept separate from the Parish maintenance account.

Contract will run from May 1st to mid October, every year. The contract will remain open, and a yearly review will be conducted in March, of every year, to discuss the wages, duties and responsibilities, and the renewal of this agreement between the two parties.
