Getting Started with Flipster



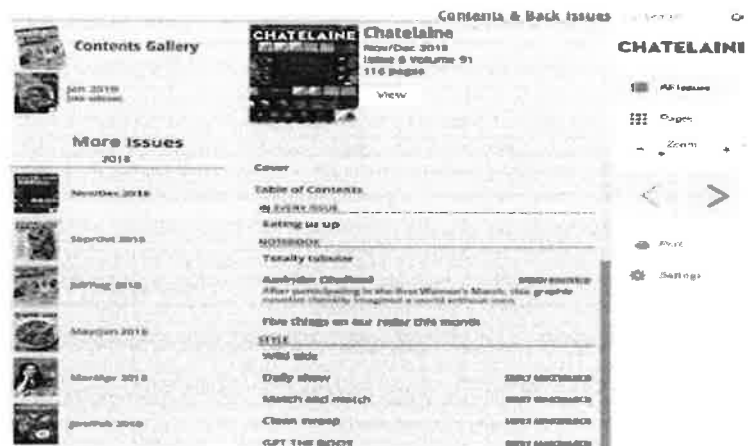
The magazines you know and love,
available digitally through your library.

Flipster allows you to read full colour current magazines from your computer, tablet, or smart phone.
Follow these steps to get started reading!

- 1) Go to the Wheatland website at www.wheatland.sk.ca.
- 2) Click on "Online Library" and choose Flipster.
- 3) If you aren't already logged in, you will be asked to type in your library barcode (with no spaces) and your PIN number. Your PIN is usually the last four digits of your phone number.
- 4) Once logged in, you can click "View All" to see what is available.
- 5) Click on the cover of any magazine to read it cover to cover!

Reading past issues:

- 1) Click on the cover of the latest edition.
- 2) On the right hand side, click on All Issues.
- 3) Scroll down to select any available issue!

Flipster Magazines on a Tablet or Smartphone

You can enjoy your Flipster magazines on iOS and Android devices as well as on Kindle Fire.

To read your magazines:

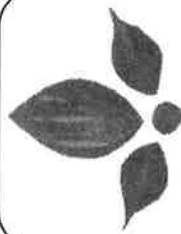
- 1) Search for "Flipster" in your App Store or Google Play Store. Download the free app.
- 2) Once the app is downloaded, click on the app to open it.
- 3) Tap "Get Started" and then search for "Wheatland Regional Library".
- 4) **Ignore the User ID and Password options, and choose the blue "Please Enter Your Barcode Here" option.**
- 5) Enter your full barcode without any spaces. The app will remember your account information so you won't need to enter this information again.
- 6) When you find a title you'd like to read, choose the download icon ( or ) to download it to your device.
- 7) If you want to read a back issue of a magazine, just click on the current edition and scroll down to see all the issues available. You can download as many back issues as you want.
- 8) There is no limit to the number of magazines you can have downloaded at one time.
- 9) Once magazines are downloaded to your device you can enjoy them without an internet connection.

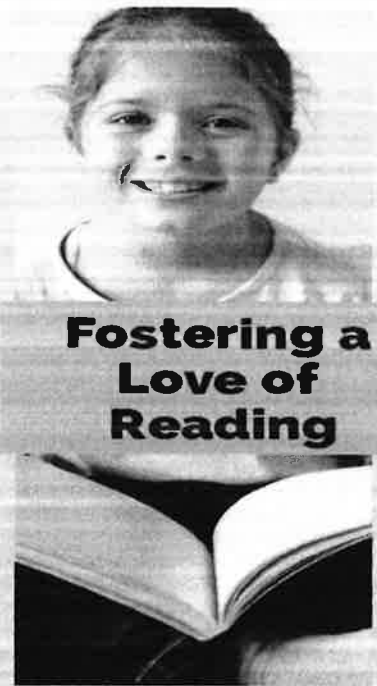

Fostering a Love of Reading

For Parents of New Readers

CHOOSING BOOKS AT THE RIGHT LEVEL

Picking a book that's too difficult can be frustrating for new readers. The five finger rule can help emerging readers identify a book at the right reading level.

Try reading the first page. Put up a finger each time they don't know a word.

- 0-1 Confidence Builder! I can read this easily
- 2-3 This is at the right level for me.
- 4-5 Difficult! I'll need help with this one!



Finding a book your child enjoys will make reading more enjoyable and encourage them to keep reading!

GIVE THESE A TRY!

Non-Fiction

Pets, volcanoes, magic tricks, dinosaurs, vehicles, outer space - anything your child is interested in we have books! Exploring topics your child enjoys can make reading fun and help boost vocabulary.

Book and CD Kits and Audiobooks

Following along with the words on the page as you listen is a great way to build reading skills for your child!

Graphic Novels

Graphic novels develop both the ability to read as well as to interpret pictures at the same time. They can also offer a fun change from traditional novels.

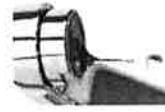

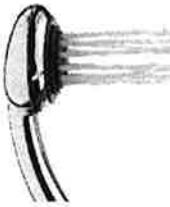
