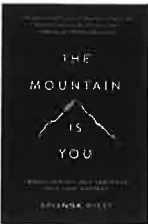
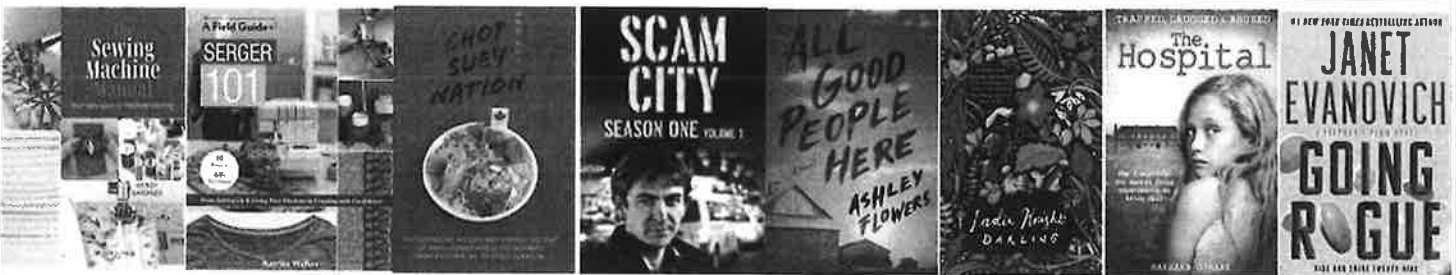
*To Find the Lost Garden: Memories, Travels, Musings and More* is a culmination of Duerr's memories, stories and old travel diaries linked together in a narrative.

"It's basically autobiographical and a compilation of writings I've done in the past, it's my story," Duerr said.

"Originally I wrote this as a family record, that was my intent originally. I just wanted to leave something of my story, my life for the family."

Born in the later part of the Great Depression in the 1940s, Duerr was raised at a farm in the Fulda area. When he was 10 his father died leaving him, his mother and sister on their own.

"As a child I was extremely ill, I almost died as a baby," he said. "We were poor but I don't think we knew we were poor. We had love, we had food and those were the important things."



Coexisting but conflicting needs create self-sabotaging behaviors. This is why we resist efforts to change, often until they feel completely futile. But by extracting crucial insight from our most damaging habits, building emotional intelligence by better understanding our brains and bodies, releasing past experiences at a cellular level, and learning to act as our highest potential future selves, we can step out of our own way and into our potential. For centuries, the mountain has been used as a metaphor for the big challenges we face, especially ones that seem impossible to overcome. To scale our mountains, we actually have to do the deep internal work of excavating trauma, building resilience, and adjusting how we show up for the climb. In the end, it is not the mountain we master, but ourselves

# 1

## TAKE AN OATH OF OFFICE

Promise to Qualify to Hold Office and Perform the Duties of your Office.

Read, Understand and Observe the Town Council's Code of Ethics.

Disclose ANY Conflict of Interest.

# 2

## COMPLETE AND SIGN PUBLIC DISCLOSURE STATEMENT

Identify your employer.

List ANY Land Holdings, Business Interests and Contracts.

The Oath of Office and The Public Disclosure Statement are Public Documents .

# 3

ALL Council Decisions must be made at Town Council Meetings that are both **OPEN** to the public and where the majority of Town Councilor's are present

Town Council Meetings that are **CLOSED** to the public are appropriate for discussing Human Resource Issues as well as discussions around Planning.

# 4

Council Members have **NO** authority to respond to complaints or requests on behalf of The Town or on behalf of the Town Council without first raising the issue at a Town Council Meeting

# 5

Council Members as well as the Mayor,

do not have ANY authority to commit the Town to expenditure, to direct the activities of the Town's Employees or to make promises without first raising the issue at a Town Council Meeting following proper process.

# 6

Understand the importance of Confidentiality and Privacy Legislation as a Municipal Government.

This means the Town Councilor will **NOT** discuss Town Business that will breach legislation outside of the Council Chambers.

# 7

Understand and abide by the necessity to support the Town Council as a whole, even if the Town Councilor does not personally agree with the outcome of a decision.

This means that if a decision made by Town Council receives a majority vote, the Town Councilor in the minority vote **MUST** support that decision as if agreed upon by all Town Councilors.
