# ZERO TOLERANCE

The Town of Bruno has adopted a policy to assist employees, Mayor and Council in their ability to perform the work required of them by providing a safe and healthy environment in which to work.

The Town of Bruno Employees, Mayor and Council have the right to work in an environment without fear or being attacked, harassed or abused. Any behavior verbal or physical which causes staff or Council to feel uncomfortable, embarrassed or threatened, is totally unacceptable.

This policy applies to all Council members, Mayor, Full-time, part-time, seasonal, temporary, hourly and salaried employees, independent contractors, agents and representative of the Town of Bruno when conducting business or performing duties or services on behalf of the Town of Bruno.

Members of the public, visitors and individuals conducting business with the Town of Bruno, including but not limited to contractors, consultants, vendors or delivery persons, are expected to refrain from any form of harassment. This shall apply to in person visits at any Municipal building or property and also to all employees, Mayor or Council who are carrying on their normal duties within the Town of Bruno.

This Zero Tolerance Policy includes aggression or threats made in person, over the telephone, in written communications via email, letter mail or on social media. The Town of Bruno considers threatening behaviour to be:

- Attempted or Actual, aggressive actions or threats made towards any member of staff, Mayor, council, contractor or Town of Bruno representative.
- The use of aggressive , threatening or abusive language (including raising of voice, swearing or cursing, shouting) which threatens or intimidates any member of staff, Mayor, council, contractor or Town of Bruno representative.

In the event of an allegation of harassment, the Town of Bruno has full discretion to take whatever temporary measures it deems appropriate to ensure the security and safety of the workplace including, but not limited to, refusal of service and location lock-down. Any instance of physical threat, harm or abuse will result in an immediate report to RCMP and will be reported to the Town of Bruno CAO for log into an incident report. Further instances may include legal action.

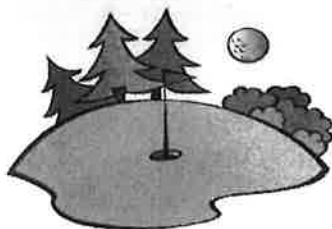
