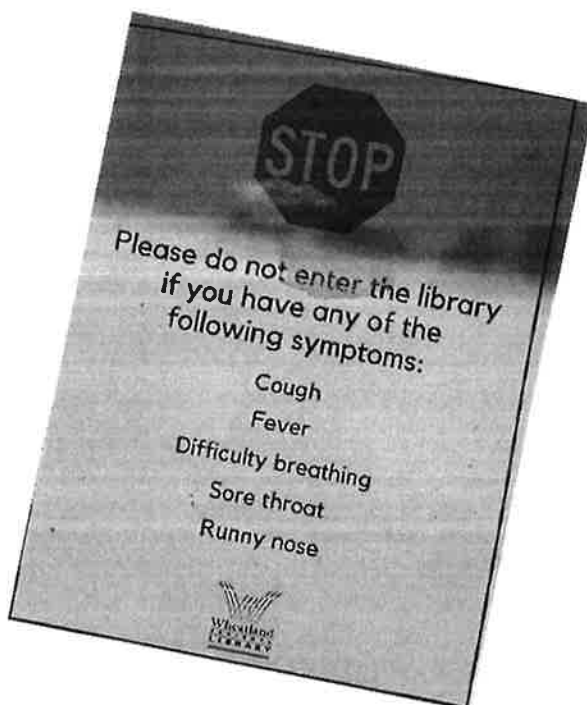

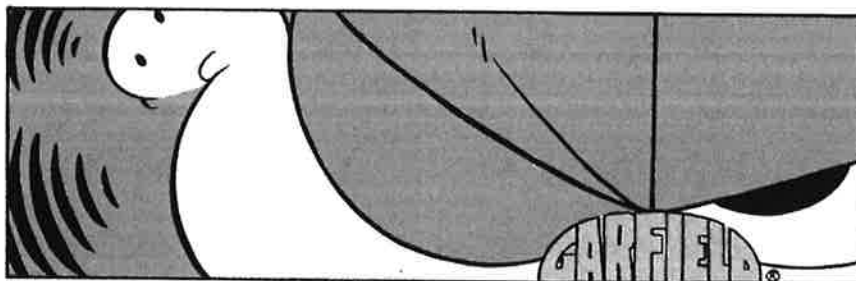

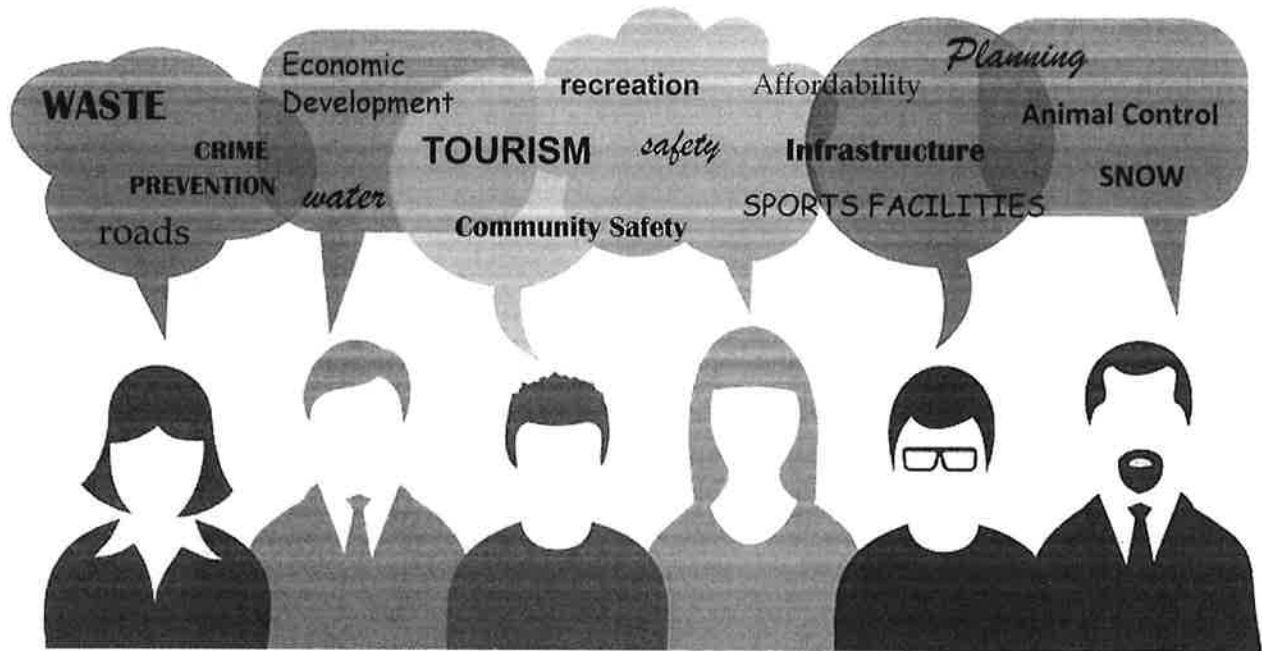

Nominations open September 9th 2020. Please see reverse for further details.

Council's main role is to make decisions about the services the municipality provides to its citizens. Council establishes policies about what essential core services to provide, how those services will be delivered and at what levels, such as:

- Roads and transportation
- Water treatment and sewer facilities
- Snow and garbage removal
- Recreation facilities and programs
- Land use planning and economic development
- Crime prevention
- Fire prevention
- Animal control
- Emergency planning

2020 ELECTION

What are the responsibilities of council?

Council has the power to make decisions about municipal services, establish policies and provide direction for the operation of the municipality. Council makes decisions about what services to provide, how those services will be delivered and at what levels. Members of council are accountable to the people who elect them.

I'm not trained & haven't had any experience...

It is not crucial to have education or experience in a government setting to run for council. You likely have skills, knowledge and abilities that are transferable to the council member's role.

Do I qualify to be a candidate?

- You must be 18 years of age on election day
- Be a Canadian citizen
- Have resided in the municipality for at least 3 consecutive months preceding the date you hand in your nomination
- Are eligible to be nominated as provided for in The Local Government Election



How much time will it require?

If elected, you will serve a four-year term. During that time, you should plan to attend the following:

- Regular & special council meetings
- Meetings of Council committees
- Meetings of other boards and agencies as a representative of council
- Conferences, seminars, workshops and conventions for training and discussion
- Events that promote or represent your municipality.

What is the purpose and role of council?

It is council's role to not only provide good government but to also provide the services and facilities that council feels necessary and desirable for all or part of the municipality. Council also fosters economic, social and environmental well being while providing wise stewardship of public assets. You could help to develop and maintain a safe and viable community.

How do I file my nomination?

Once the Town of Bruno publishes a *Notice of Call for Nominations*, you can file your completed nomination paper and all required attachments with Colette at the Town Office during regular office hours. If you need assistance with your form or have questions please contact the Town Office.
