## ST. THERESE NEWS

Last month we shared some details of what it means to say St. Therese Institute is a Catholic cultural institute, sharing how the institute supports Catholic culture and identity across communities in Western Canada.

The main mission of this Catholic cultural institute is to run a formation program for young adults aged 18-27. In this article, I will try to define what "Catholic Formation" is.

The formation concept is rooted in the idea that we each have a distinct destiny, as children of God, but that having a destiny is not a passive thing. We don't exist for the experience alone. We were created for a reason, and we need to respond with action. Responding properly is something we need to be taught to do.

A Catholic worldview is rooted in the belief that we are each alive to become the specific saint whom God saw in His mind's eye when He first thought of you or me. That was way back - before the world began or any of the stars existed. Then God waited until this time and place, and He brought you into being now, to play a part in His purposes. He wanted the saint you will become through the combination of your personality, interests, talent, and even fears and failures. He wanted that saint to play an unrepeatable role at this point in history. So, your story of finding and using the strengths you were born with and navigating the weaknesses you were given has meaning within the great story of Love - of Good triumphing over Evil - that God is unfolding through creation. That's a big idea, if it's true, but it isn't new. These ideas have been with us for a long time. This is the precise reason that people of western cultures - the cultures of Christian heritage - are unique in the world for tending to say, "yeah, life has a purpose." Such a bold belief is rooted in this bigger picture.

In short, my role in life is to become - or be "formed" into - somebody who is much better than the person I am now. Catholic Formation teaches me to understand and embrace that practically.

It takes a learning process for me to trust that I can look at everything about my life - my joys as well as my sufferings, my work and my hopes together - as a constant flow of opportunities to be formed and then reformed, throughout the time I am given on earth, until I become that person I was born to be. I learn how much I need God's grace even to believe in it - much

more to make the transformation happen. By the way - saying I need grace just means I need God's help - I can't do it under my own strength.

The Formation program at St. Therese Institute puts young people in touch with resources for their transformation - their "reformation" - into saints. They take up an education program, learning about the Catholic Church, with the great story of hope that it has told in every generation and place, which is called the gospel, or "the Good News". They learn how this good news has looked throughout history, where they can see it revealed in scripture and Church doctrine, and how it has formed the lives of countless people before them. This is inspiring for their visions of themselves.

Then they learn that to truly live out the love that makes us saints, we must live for purposes outside ourselves - for God first and for other people second. "I am third", they learn to say. This is poetic to think about. It is grittier to try to live it in a community of real people. But life in community is where love is truly tested, and that's the test that young people at St. Therese Institute are presented with, through the life we live in shared spaces and routines of the residence.

Our formation programming is broken into three offerings - a Catholic Gap Year that gives the core formation experience, a Mission Year for people who come back after a Gap Year to add a service component to their formation experience, and a third internship year that focuses on formation in professional skills. Through these three options, we hope to give young Catholics a chance to catch the greatest vision they can for themselves, at the heart of the greatest story that has ever been told.

### Program Overview

### Division 5 Vote for Councillor

The Rural Municipality of Bayne No. 371 will be holding a **by-election** to fill the office of Councillor for **Division 5**. All eligible voters are reminded that voting in a rural municipal election is governed by *The Local Government Elections Act, 2015* and the Saskatchewan Voter's Guide.

### Who Can Vote in the Division 5 By-Election?

You may vote if you are:

- At least 18 years of age on election day, **and**
  - A Canadian citizen, **and**
- **One of the following:**
  - A resident in **DIVISION 5**, or
  - The registered owner of assessed land in **DIVISION 5**, or
  - The lessee of assessed land in **DIVISION 5**, or
  - The spouse of one of the above in **DIVISION 5** .

### Voting Division Rules


- Each voter is entitled to vote in only one division of the Rural Municipality.
- **You must vote in the division where you reside.**
- **If you do not reside in the municipality, you must vote in the division where you hold the greatest total assessed value of land.**
- These rules are set out in sections 36–39 of *The Local Government Elections Act, 2015* and explained in the Voter's Guide.

### Non-Residents (assessed landowners/lessees, etc.)

- If a person **does not reside in the RM**, but is assessed in **more than one division**, they may designate in writing to the Administrator **which division** they wish to vote in (s. 39(7)).
- This designation must be filed **before September 1** of the year of the election.
- Once filed, the designation remains in effect until they file a new one (s. 39(8)).
- If no designation presented, the person(s) vote in the division with the highest assessed land.


