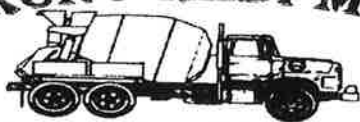

Truth & Reconciliation Day – September 30th

The Town of Bruno wishes to acknowledge September 30th as Truth & Reconciliation Day and in doing so urge our staff and residents to show support by wearing an orange shirt that day.

The day honours the lost children and survivors of residential schools, their families and communities.

Although the Federal Government has designated this a Statutory holiday for Federal workers, there has been no instruction by the Provincial Government to do so.

Orange Shirt Day is an Indigenous-led grassroots commemorative day that honours the children who survived Indian Residential Schools and remembers those who did not. This day relates to the experience of Phyllis Webstad, a Northern Secwepemc (Shuswap) from the Stswecem'c Xgat'tem First Nation, on her first day of school, where she arrived dressed in a new orange shirt, which was taken from her. It is now a symbol of the stripping away of culture, freedom and self-esteem experienced by Indigenous children over generations.

Town of Bruno – Speedbump & Radar Sign Update

The Town of Bruno Council has resolved to address excessive speed in our Town.

The radar sign placed on Grid road has been a huge success and Council will budget for more of these types of signs in the future.

The speed bumps that were placed on Hoffman Avenue were placed there by The Town as a trial run. This location was chosen by Council at their June 15th Council meeting and is reflected in the minutes. To be clear, the location chosen had nothing to do with any resident or the proximity of the CAO's residence, it was strictly a Council decision.

Resident feedback is generally positive with a number of people requesting speed bump installation on their streets.

Additional speed bump locations will be added in the Spring of 2022.

The RCMP wish to convey that if the Town Residents have concerns or incidents to report of unsafe or erratic driving, please reach out to them and report these incidents. Vehicle color, make and license plate numbers would be helpful but any information you can supply is worthwhile. RCMP number is 306-682-2535. Charges can only be laid if you are willing to give a signed statement to the RCMP and you are willing to appear in court if needed.

Please have all overgrown trees and shrubs on your property trimmed. It is the responsibility of the property owner to ensure their trees and shrubs are not obstructing the view or use of any:

- Sidewalks
- Roads
- Alleyways
- Street Signs
- House Numbers
- Fire Hydrants

REACT Transfer station accepts tree trimmings and branches at no charge!

Please note if trimming is not done and the Town of Bruno is required to cut them, you may be charged for the services.

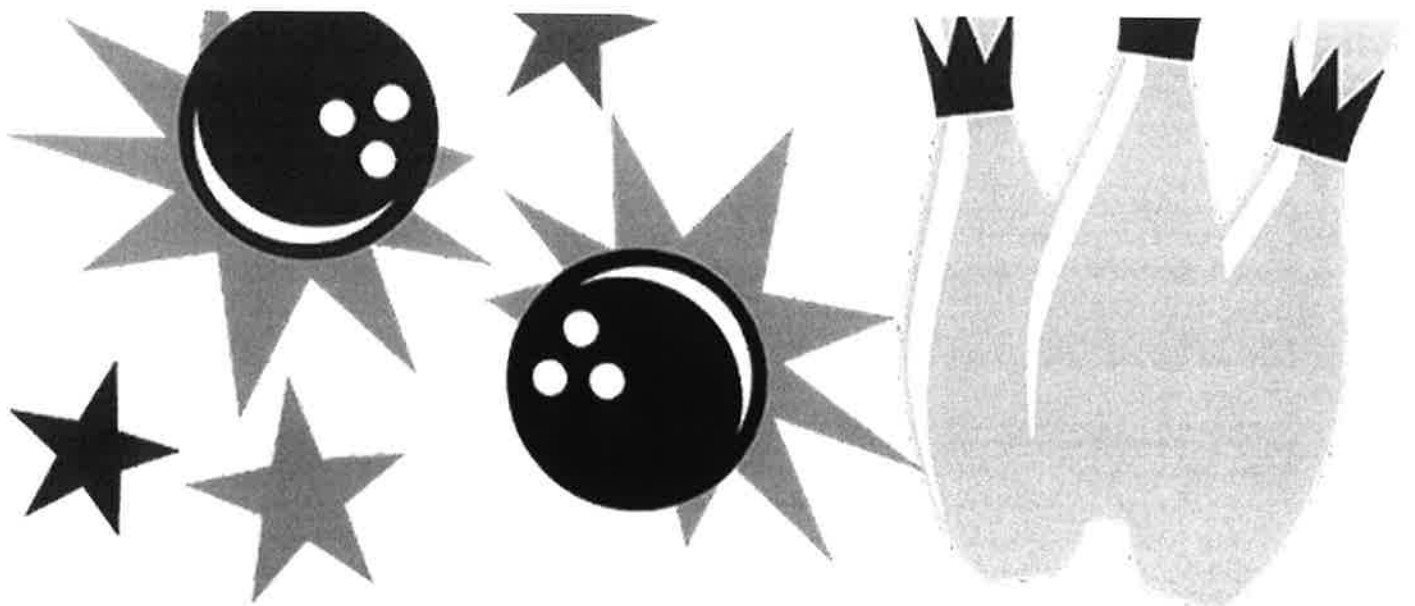

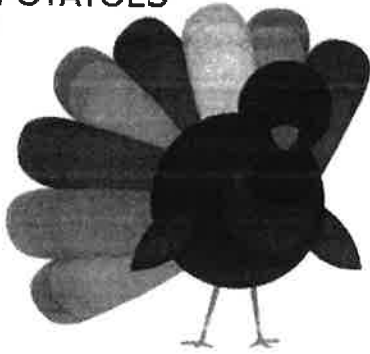

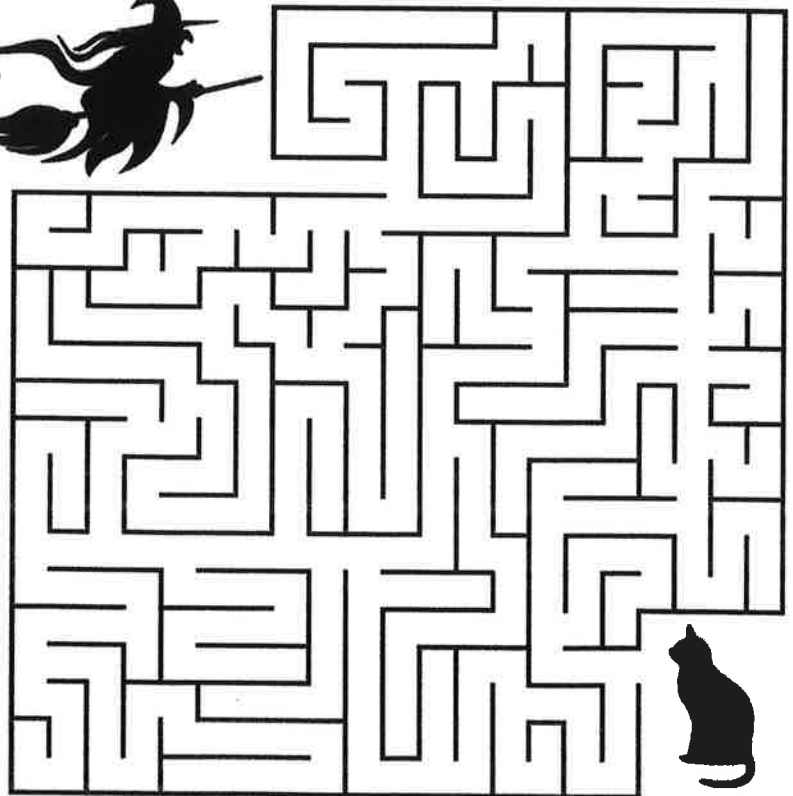

Volunteer Recognition Award

The volunteer recognition program is organized by
The Town of Bruno in conjunction with The RM of Bayne

to recognize the contributions that volunteers provide to sport, culture, recreation and overall community involvement. Its purpose is to recognize the volunteer contributions of people active in developing, administering or providing programs and activities.

Nominations must fall under one or more of the following categories:

- **SPORT** – An individual whose leadership qualities contribute to the development of sport. This can include leadership, coaching, administration or participation in physical activities for enjoyment, fitness or excellence at all skill levels.
- **RECREATION** – An individual who has shown exemplary community service in the leadership and administration of leisure activities. Recreation can include sport, fitness, heritage, social, cultural, intellectual activity or outdoor pursuits.
- **CULTURE** – An individual whose volunteer efforts have contributed to the overall cultural identity of their community. This may encompass the area of heritage conservation, arts, or multiculturalism.
- **COMMUNITY INVOLVEMENT** - An individual who has shown exemplary community involvement and development. The individual has exhibited strong community spirit and pride and has enhanced the community through their actions.

Nomination will be accepted until 4:00 PM November 15, 2021
