BYLAW 04/2025

**A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF BRUNO TO CONTROL THE BURNING OF MATERIALS
AND TO PROVIDE FOR PROVISION OF FIRE BANS
WITHIN TOWN LIMITS**

The council of the Town of Bruno in the province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

- 1) The burning of garbage, leaf litter, compost, animal waste, or flammable and combustible material is prohibited within the Town of Bruno limits.
- 2) Fire pits intended for the purpose of backyard barbeques, weiner roasts, social gatherings, etc are to be
 - a. In a properly constructed brick or metallic burner with a suitable 1/8th inch mesh covering or grate.
 - b. Situated a minimum of 10 feet away from any building or structure.
 - c. Burn only clean wood.
 - d. Under constant supervision.
 - e. Have some form of extinguishment on site.
- 3) Burning Barrels are not permitted.
- 4) Covered propane or charcoal barbeques are permitted during a fire ban but must be under constant supervision and have some sort of extinguishment on site.
- 5) The Fire Chief or next in command, Mayor or Deputy Mayor can declare a fire ban within Town limits.
- 6) Fire bans would include no open fire pit usage, fireworks or Sky Lanterns
- 7) Rescinding a fire ban may be by means of the onset of Rain or if the risk has passed; to be determined by the fire chief.
- 8) Violation of the provisions of this Bylaw is guilty of an offense and liable on summary convictions to the penalties set out below:
 - a. First Offense \$100.00
 - b. Second Offense \$200.00
 - c. Third & Subsequent Offenses \$500.00
 - i. In the event that the Fire Department is called to attend and/or extinguish a fire started during a fire ban, the violator shall also be charged the fire department response fees as set out in the Fire Department Bylaw.
- 9) The Fire Chief and the Bruno & District Volunteer Fire Department in itself have powers to act on behalf of the Municipality, its residents and businesses and to any Mutual Aid agreements as legislated within the Fire Safety Act.

10) Bylaw 03/2016 is hereby repealed

11) This Bylaw shall come into force upon approval of the final reading and adoption of this Bylaw.
