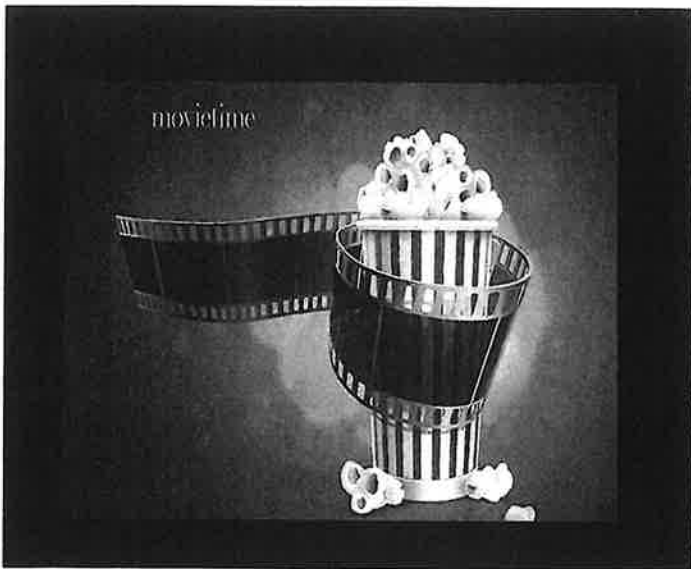
### ST. THERESE NEWS

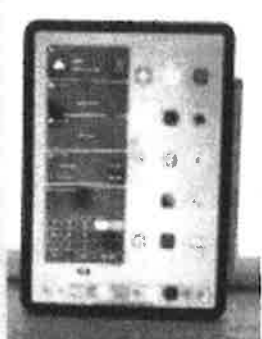
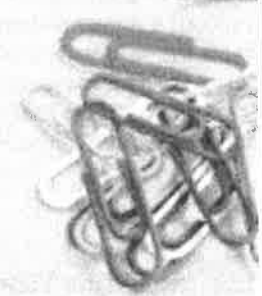

It is your responsibility as the property owner / tenant to ensure your trees stay on your property so please check yours and trim accordingly.*

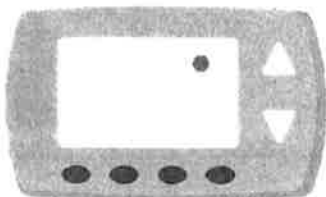

The Public Works Staff will be working hard to tree chip and remove yard waste throughout September and October.

When piling yard waste for pick-up, please have it bagged in clear or coloured bags adjacent to your lane way. IF IT IS IN BLACK GARBAGE BAGS IT MAY BE MISTAKEN AS GARBAGE AND LEFT. *Mixed loose piles will **not** be picked up by the Town of Bruno Public Works Staff.* Yard Waste is **FREE** to haul to the transfer station during open hours.
